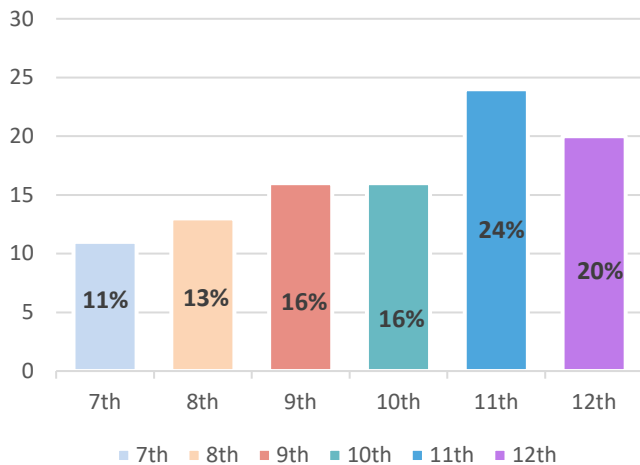

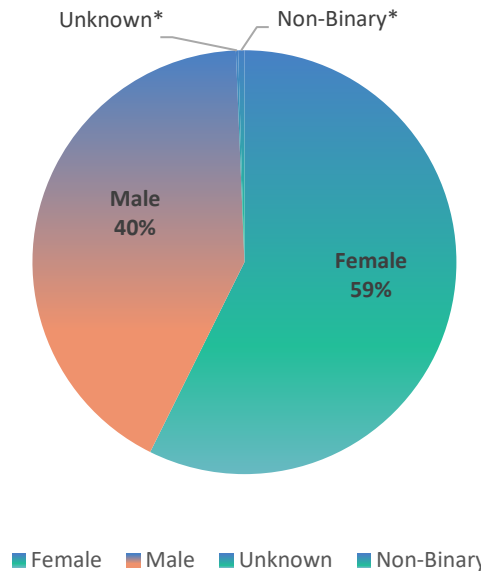
2021-2022 SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY ENTRY PROGRAM

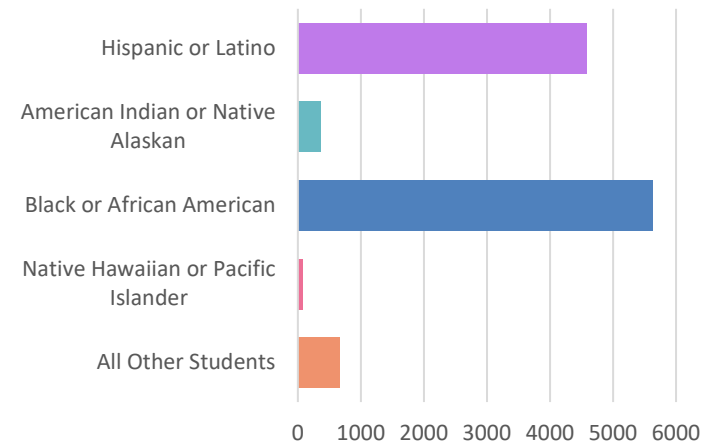


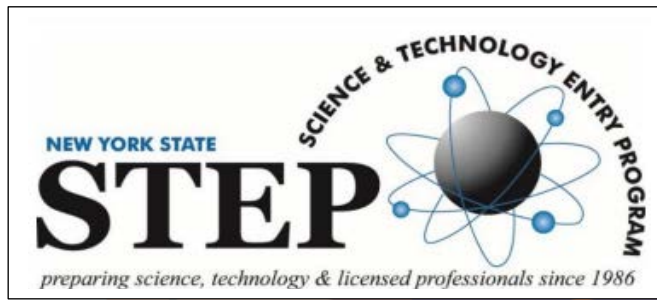
