<ul> <li>The student and the parent of the student must receive a copy of this documentation and written notification of the superintendent's decision.</li> <li>Where the superintendent determined that the student has not met the requirements for graduation, the notice must inform the student that they have the right to attend school until receipt of a local or Regents diploma or until the end of the school year in which the student turns 21, whichever shall occur first.</li> <li>Where the superintendent determined that the student has met the requirements for graduation, written notice must be provided that the student is no longer entitled to enroll in high school.</li> <li>If the student is under age 18 or is a student with a disability that has an individualized education program (IEP), and is not emancipated, the parent may refuse a Special Determination to graduate with a local diploma.</li> <li>If a student with a disability has an IEP and/or other documentation from the Committee on Special Education (CSE) indicating the plan for the student was to remain in school and continue their educational program, a school or district shall not confer a diploma until they receive confirmation to do so from the parent or person in parental relation.</li> </ul>
