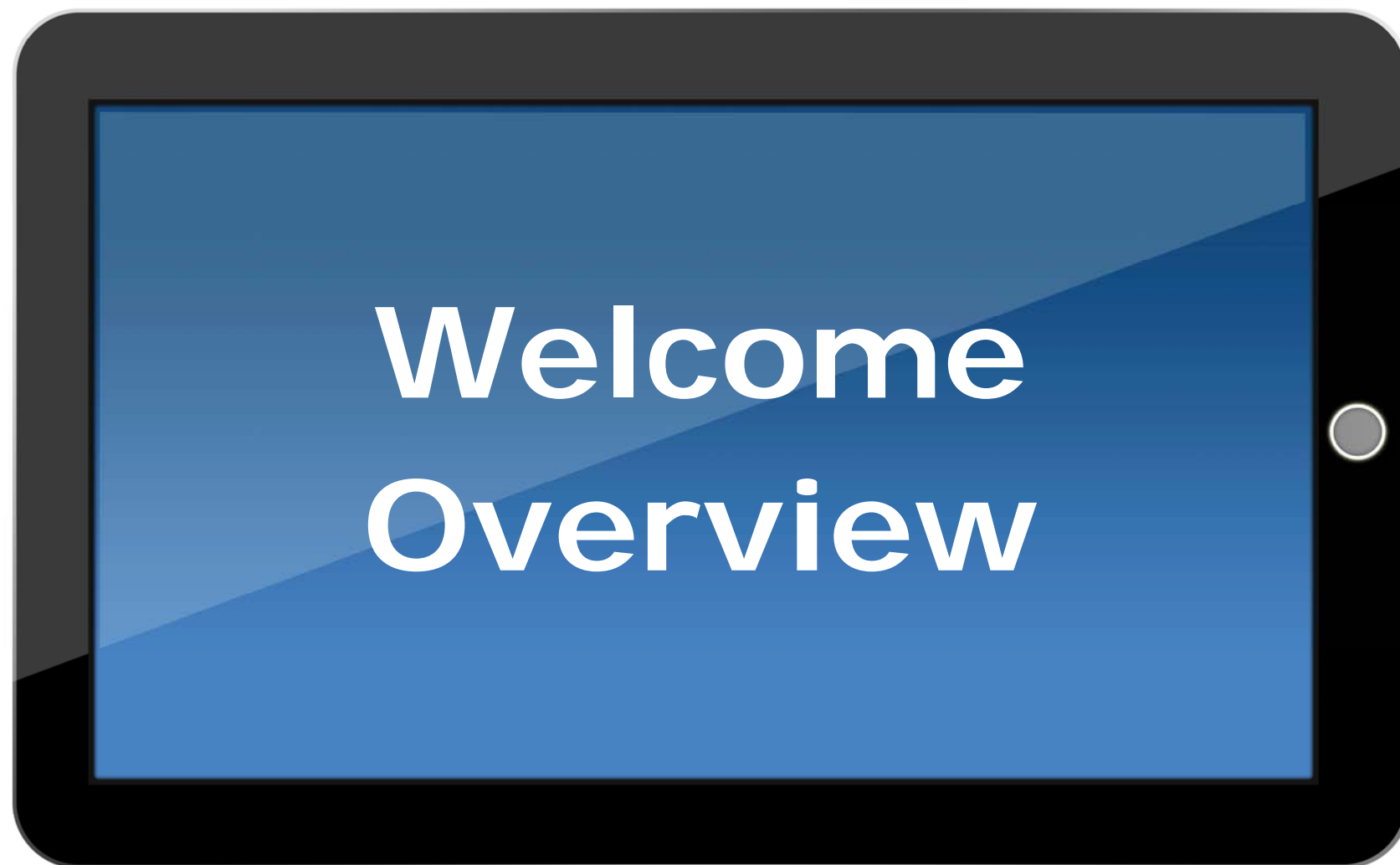

- Continue to refine the tool and associated documentation based on feedback from multiple stakeholders



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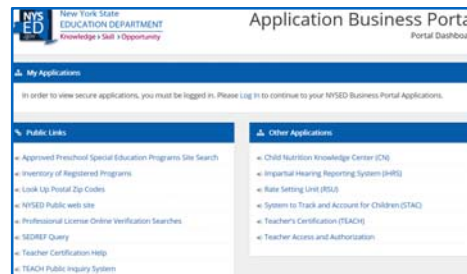




