APPR Summaries for 2018-19 Staff Evaluation Score and Rating Distribution and Data Submission

Each district and BOCES with an approved APPR plan for 2018-19 will receive a summary of their approved 2018-19 APPR plan as a resource to use when calculating scores and ratings for teachers and principals, and when submitting staff evaluation data to the Department for the October 18, 2019 staff evaluation data submission deadline. Please note this summary is an update of the 2017-18 APPR Summary to reflect changes resulting from the 2019 amendments to Education Law §3012-d made in the enacted budget. All districts and BOCES should utilize the updated summary.

Accessing the APPR Summary

All APPR summaries will be posted in June in the <u>IRS Portal</u> (IRSP). District personnel who have access to the IRSP should log in and download the APPR summary in preparation for the calculation, distribution, and submission of staff evaluation scores and ratings for 2018-19. Regional Information Centers will also receive the APPR summaries for all districts and BOCES in their area, which will assist in their ability to provide technical assistance throughout the staff evaluation data submission process.

Components of the APPR Summary

General information

Each APPR summary contains the name of the district or BOCES, SED Code, and approval date of the plan approved for the 2018-19 school year at the beginning of the summary and in the file name. Be sure the correct version of the APPR plan is referenced when calculating staff evaluation scores and ratings. All approved APPR plans are posted on the NYSED website.

The APPR summary is broken up according to the type of scores and ratings needed for a group of educators. Most APPR summaries contain three groups of educators:

- Student performance scores and ratings based on ORIGINAL measures
 - These evaluations are based on the original measures/assessments included in Task 2/7 of the APPR plan, which <u>are not</u> based, in whole or in part, on the NYS grades 3-8 ELA or math assessments or on a State-provided growth score.
- Student performance scores and ratings based on ALTERNATE SLOs
 - The original measures/assessments indicated in Task 2/7 of the APPR plan for these evaluations are based, in whole or in part, on the NYS grades 3-8 ELA or math assessments or on a State-provided growth score. 2/7 Transition of the APPR plan (for plans approved after March 10, 2016) or on the Supplemental Form for Alternate SLOs (for plans approved prior to March 11, 2016).

LEAs with principals of grades 9-12 have an additional grouping:

This back-up SLO should be used as the required student performance measure.



Organization

Each section of the summary begins with general information about the group of educators included in that section and whether they should have original or transition scores and ratings.



Original versus Transition

The APPR summary is color coded based on the type of scores and ratings needed:

Original (shaded in blue)

All information in these sections pertains to original scores and ratings for educators whose original measures as included in Task 2/7 of the approved APPR plan are not based on NYS grades 3-8 ELA or math assessments and/or State-provided growth scores.

Transition (shaded in orange)


All information in these sections pertains to transition scores and ratings – those, based on Alternate SLOs for educators whose original measures as included in Task 2/7 of the approved APPR plan include the use of NYS grades 3-8 ELA or math assessments and/or State-provided growth scores

Denotes that the information listed comes from Task 2 Transition (teachers) or Task 7 Transition (principals) of the APPR plan (for plans approved after March 10, 2016) or from the Supplemental Form for Alternate SLOs (for plans approved prior to March 11, 2016).

Sections

Student Performance

The student performance section lists measures and assessments organized by teachers/principals. All sets of educators included in the APPR plan are listed, as grouped in the APPR plan, combined based on common measures and assessments. Non-core courses and electives are listed exactly as included in the APPR plan in Task 2.10.



The optional subcomponent will be included, but, if not used, shaded in grey.

For educators who should receive original scores and ratings, the basis of these scores and ratings – the SLO measures and assessments included in Task 2 (teachers) and Task 7 (principals) of the APPR plan – are listed (see figure above).

For educators who should receive transition scores and ratings, the basis of these scores and ratings – the Alternate SLO measures and assessments included in Task 2 Transition (teachers) or Task 7 Transition (principals) of the APPR plan (for plans approved after March 10, 2016 or from the Supplemental Form for Alternate SLOs for plans approved prior to March 11, 2016) – are listed (see figure below).

For these educators, the original measures and assessments (italicized) included in Task 2 (teachers) and Task 7 (principals) of the APPR plan are also listed to indicate why transition scores and ratings should be provided instead of original scores and ratings.








