A. Organization

- Task 7.1 pertains to principals with at least 30% of their students covered under a State-provided growth measure.
- Task 7.2 must be used for principals in buildings or programs in which fewer than 30% of students take the NYS grades 4-8 ELA assessments or do not have all of grades 9-12 in the building, and thus require an SLO.



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- **B.** Assurances
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B. Assurances

- All assurances are mandatory.
- In Task 7, assurances are included in Tasks 7.1 and 7.5.
- Be sure to always read, understand, and check all assurances.

7.1) Assurances Assure that the growth score provided by NYSED will be used, where required. Assure that back-up SLOs will be set by the superintendent or another trained administrator for all principals who receive a State-provided growth score in the event that a State-provided growth score cannot be generated for that principal.





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
C. State-Provided Measures of Student Growth

- Principals in grades 4-8 ELA, math, and/or high school courses with State or Regents assessments (with all of grades 9-12)
- At least 30% of students are covered under a Stateprovided growth measure
- Receive a State-provided growth score
- Require back-up SLOs
- An example of entering a back-up SLO is shown on the following slide.



C. State-Provided Measures of Student Growth

- The district/BOCES will first enter the lowest and highest grades of the building/program.
- The assessment options for Task 7.1 are listed as checkbox menus, which allow for the selection of multiple assessments.




To add an additional configuration, check the box as shown.



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- Principals in buildings or programs in which fewer than 30% of students take grades 4-8 ELA, math, and/or high school courses with State or Regents assessments.
- Multiple measures are available for use with SLOs.
- The district/BOCES will first enter the lowest and highest grade of the building/program then select a measure.
- Once a measure has been selected from the dropdown menu, a corresponding menu of assessments will appear.



To add an additional configuration, check the box as shown.



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E. Assigning 0-20 Scores and HEDI Rating

 Task 7.3 contains the State-determined HEDI scoring bands that must be used when assigning 0-20 scores and HEDI ratings to principals.

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F. Weighting

- If the Optional subcomponent (addressed in Task 8) is not used, the Required subcomponent will be weighted 100% of the Student Performance category.
- If the Optional subcomponent is used, the Required subcomponent must comprise at least 50% of the Student Performance category.
 - The use of the Optional subcomponent and corresponding weighting, as applicable, is entered into Task 7.6, shown below.

Please indicate the use of the Optional subcomponent by checking the box below. Information related to the Optional subcomponent will be entered into Task 8.

- The Optional subcomponent WILL NOT be used; the Required subcomponent will comprise 100% of the Student Performance category.
- The Optional subcomponent WILL be used; the weight of each subcomponent is indicated below.

Select the weight of the Required Student Performance subcomponent; the corresponding Optional Student Performance subcomponent weight is shown.
