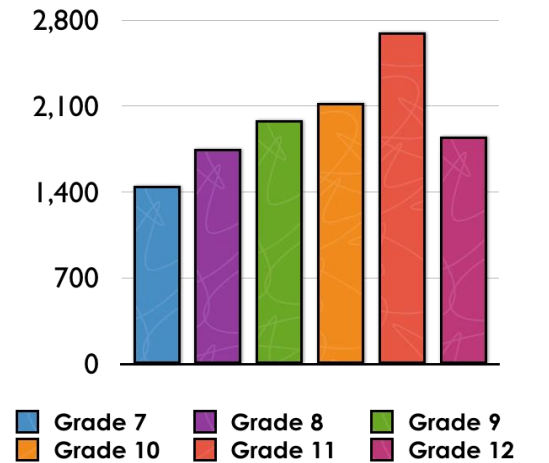
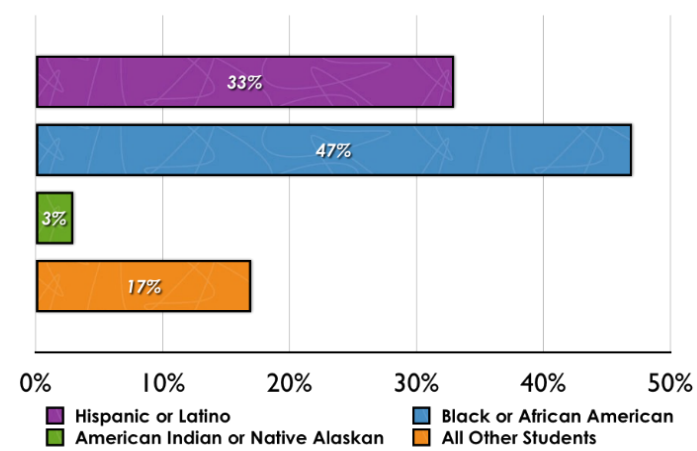
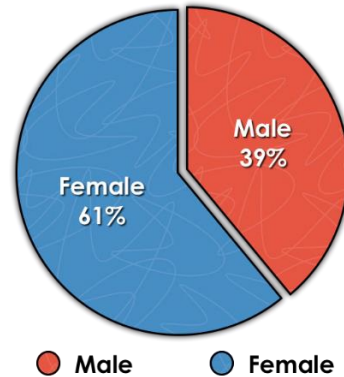
Students participated in 459 **Internship** activities, totaling 39,721 hours:

## 2017-2018 SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY ENTRY PROGRAM

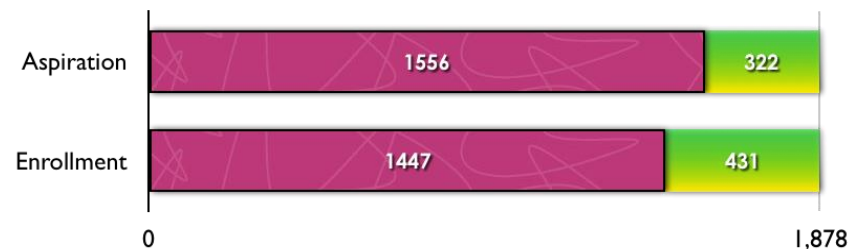
