The chart below provides information on students with disabilities who are eligible to participate in the 2017–18 New York State English as a Second Language Achievement Test (NYSESLAT). English Language Learners/Multilingual Learners (ELLs/MLLs) who are graded must take the State examination for the grade level in which they are enrolled. The chart below is to be used solely to ascertain the appropriate NYSESLAT grade band test to administer to those ELLs/MLLs with disabilities who are ungraded.
