Students should take exams in as many modalities as possible to qualify for a point for criterion 2D. When a language has exams available in less than all modalities, the student should take exams in as many modalities as possible. For instance, a student who wishes to earn the NYSSB in Romanian can earn a point for criterion 2D by taking only the OPI, as that is the only exam available in Romanian. If an exam exists in all modalities for the language in which the student is pursuing the NYSSB, then the student must take the exam that exists in all modalities.
