Checkpoint A students deserve rich, engaging units that maximize target language use and build global awareness. Learn to apply key principles of unit design to your setting. Explore a case study of how a textbook chapter on the house can be transformed into a thematic unit about the tiny house movement and variations in global dwellings. You will leave with a toolbox that supports you in transforming an existing unit or creating a new one.



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Rebecca Blouwolff has taught French at Wellesley Middle School in Massachusetts since 1998, but fell in love with middle schoolers while teaching English in France. Novice students inspire her to create engaging, age-appropriate lessons focused on global awareness. She served as the 2020 National Language Teacher of the Year, the 2019 MaFLA and NECTFL Teacher of the Year, and is a National Board Certified Teacher.
