


#### So what's it all about?

Teams have been established in Grades K-2, 3-6, 7-12


Teachers chosen had to be recommended by the District Administrators and meet rubric criteria of Grant

- Break down of Spending

  - 6 courses (18 credit hours for teachers) and a Certificate of Advanced Study
