An Invitation to Apply for Principal Leadership Positions

The St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES is seeking administrators interested in becoming Principal Leaders for the remainder of this school year through June 2015. These principal leaders will be tasked with assisting regional/local colleagues. Currently we are seeking 6 Regional Principal Leaders currently serving at the Primary, Secondary, or K-12 levels. Funding for these positions will be provided by the Strengthening Teacher and Leader Effectiveness Grant. Regional principal leaders will remain in their current position for both years and will receive a stipend for additional duties.

Duties and Expectations for Administrative Leadership Positions

Regional Principal Leaders (\$2000 stipend per year):

- Mentor new principals
- Provide support to regional principals on area of expertise
- Serve on Regional Professional Development Committee
- Participate in Instructional Training and Implementation (December 7-11, 2014)

Areas of Expertise:

- Instructional Rounds Process
- SLC
- Curriculum Development
- Assessment Development
- Data Driven Instruction
- Teacher Observation (Rubric)
- Scheduling
- Others as brainstormed by Principal's groups

Eligibility:

- 5+ Years of Administrative Experience
- Effective or Highly Effective APPR rating in 2012-13 and 2013-14
- Experience implementing the RTTT initiatives

Each leader will:

- Be assigned 1 to 2 first/second year principals to whom they will support by answering questions by phone/email.
- attend Regional Professional Development Committee meetings.
- the Instructional Rounds training be prepared to lead/participate in 2-3 rounds in the spring 2014. (2 to 3 days)
