Participate in on-site job- embedded coaching seminar sponsored by NYSUT	 Tentatively scheduled to take place in early October Organized by Danielle and Kim in conjunction with WSBOCES and NYSUT
Plan and develop curriculum support resources	 Coordinate with curriculum administrator to identify and develop 2 curriculum resource projects Projects will be completed as an independent project and then shared with colleagues
Conduct turn-key training for peers	 At a minimum conduct 2 turn-key trainings for the year Turn-key trainings will be planned collaboratively with your curriculum administrator and may take place during morning pd, a p-period, a faculty meeting or during the school day with sub coverage
Participate in Teacher Studio	 Form a group of 3-4 teachers and one administrator (mix of teacher leaders and non-teacher leaders in group) Each of the teachers in the group will teach one lesson where they are observed by the other members of the group Members of each group will meet before the lesson for a pre-observation meeting and after the lesson for a post observation meeting The group should plan two observations per semester
Have an open classroom for non- evaluative peer observations	 Invite peers in to observe model lessons Document at least one visitation per semester

Participate in a collegial circle	Meet with other teacher leaders in your school building at least 6 times a year over the course of the school year
