Please be advised that Northeastern Seminary at Roberts Wesleyan College is voluntarily withdrawing from institutional accreditation by the New York State Board of Regents and Commissioner of Education, effective September 6, 2016. The Seminary holds accreditation from the Commission on Accrediting of the Association of Theological Schools and the Middle States Commission on Higher Education. We have recently received approval from the United States Department of Education for our primary accreditor to be changed to the Commission on Accrediting of the Association of Theological Schools.
