

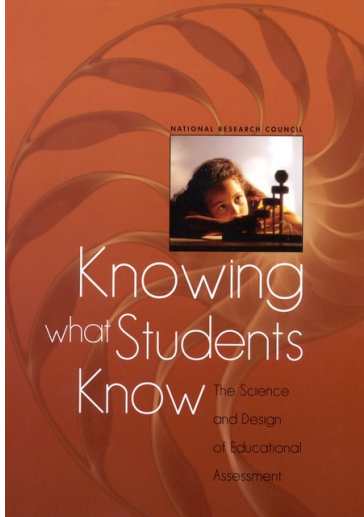

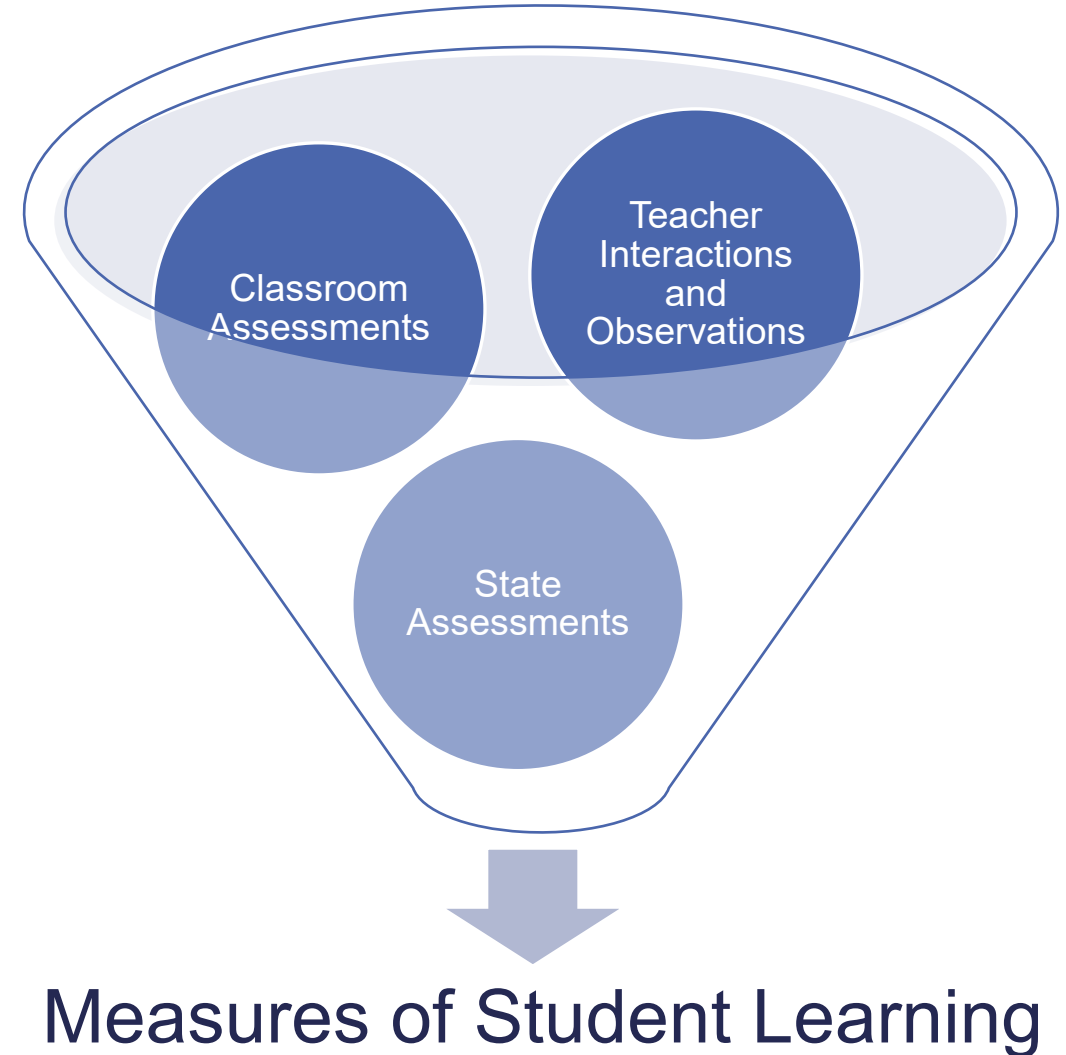

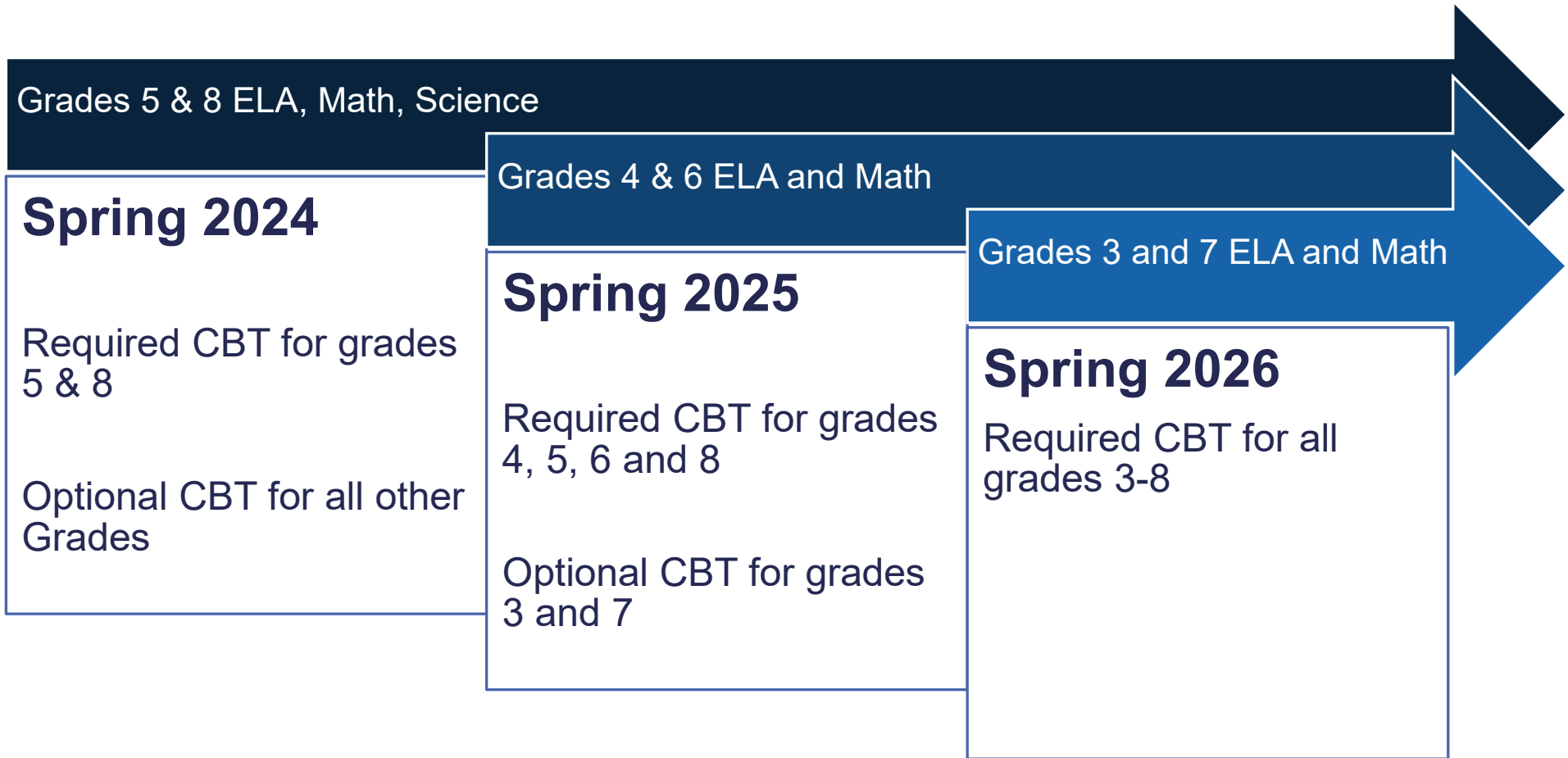


CBT Implementation Timeline

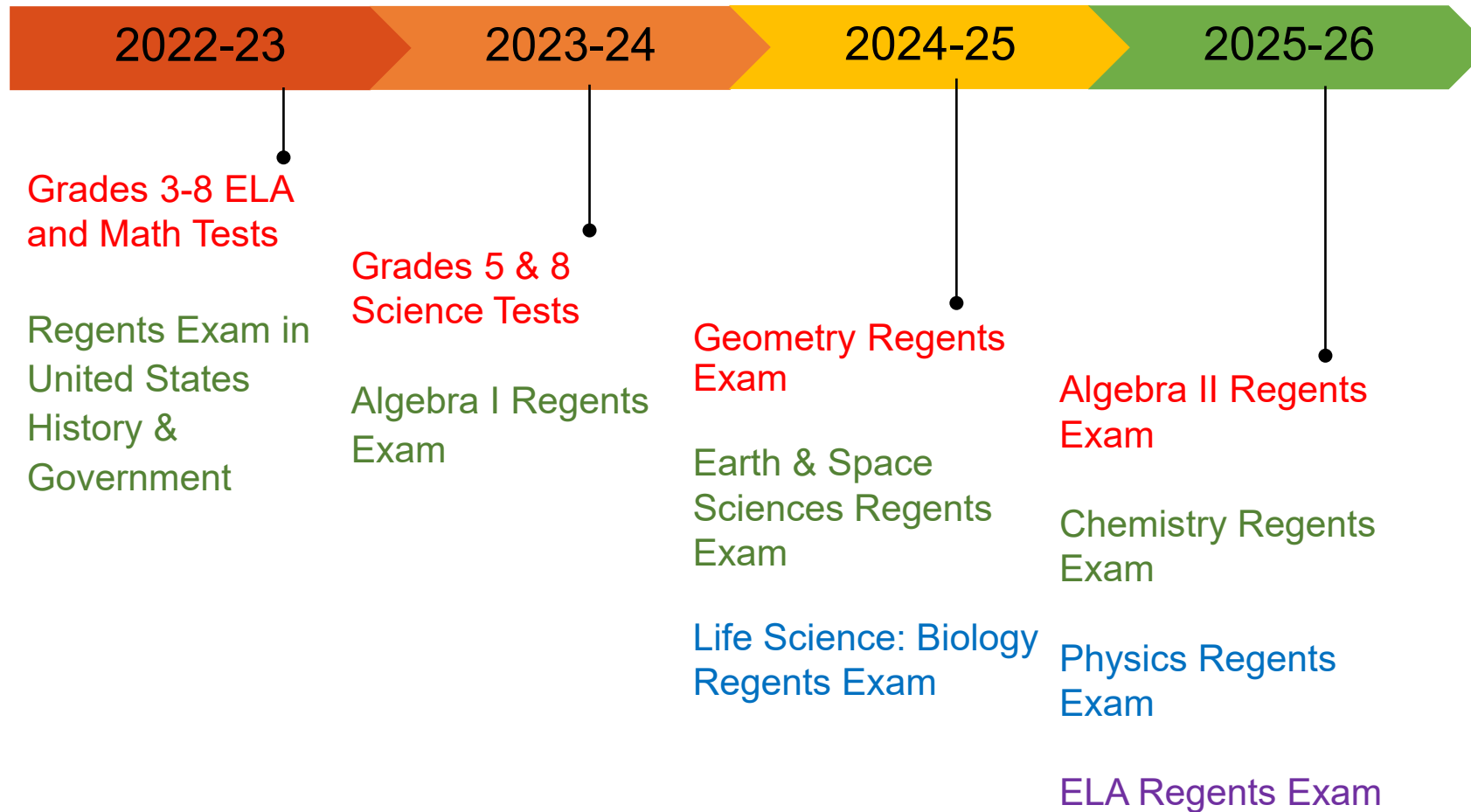
Grades 3-8 ELA, Math, and Grades 5 and 8 Science

- Full implementation of required administration on computer will take place over the next several years according to the following timeline:
 - 2024 – Required CBT administration in Grades 5 and 8 ELA, Math, and Science
 - 2025 – Required CBT administration in Grades 4, 5, 6, and 8
 - 2026 – Required CBT administration for all Grades 3-8
- Any schools that have not yet participated in computer-based administration of the Grades 3-8 tests are strongly encouraged to participate in CBT for field testing in Spring 2023
- Schools continue to have the option of participating in operational CBT in any grade/content area prior to its requirement
