



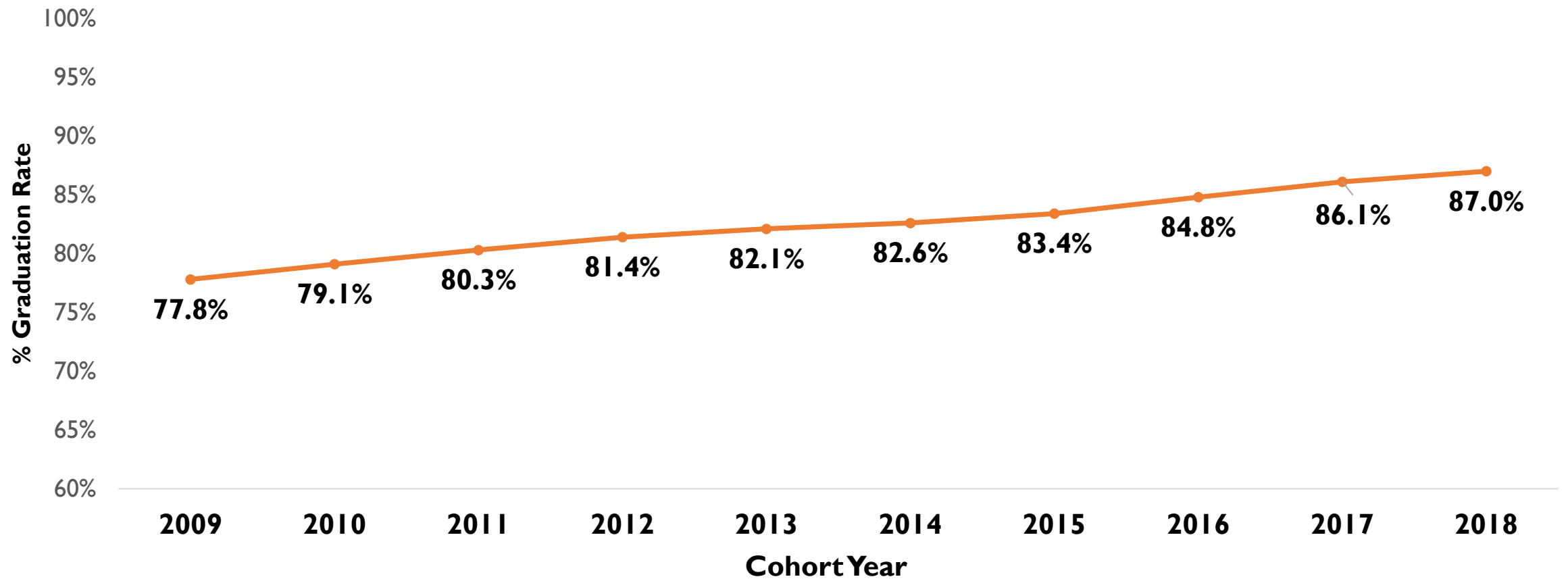

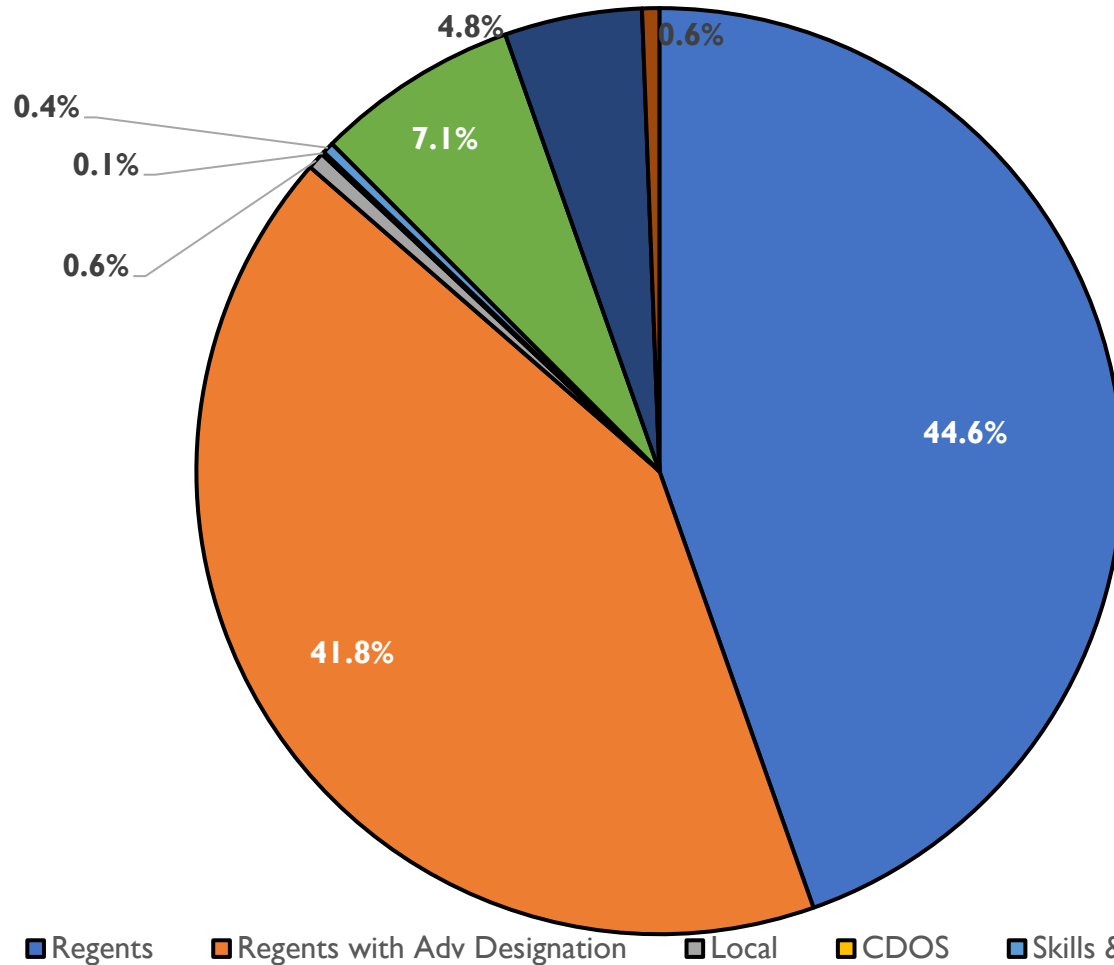

2018 COHORT 4-YEAR STATEWIDE OUTCOMES – AUGUST



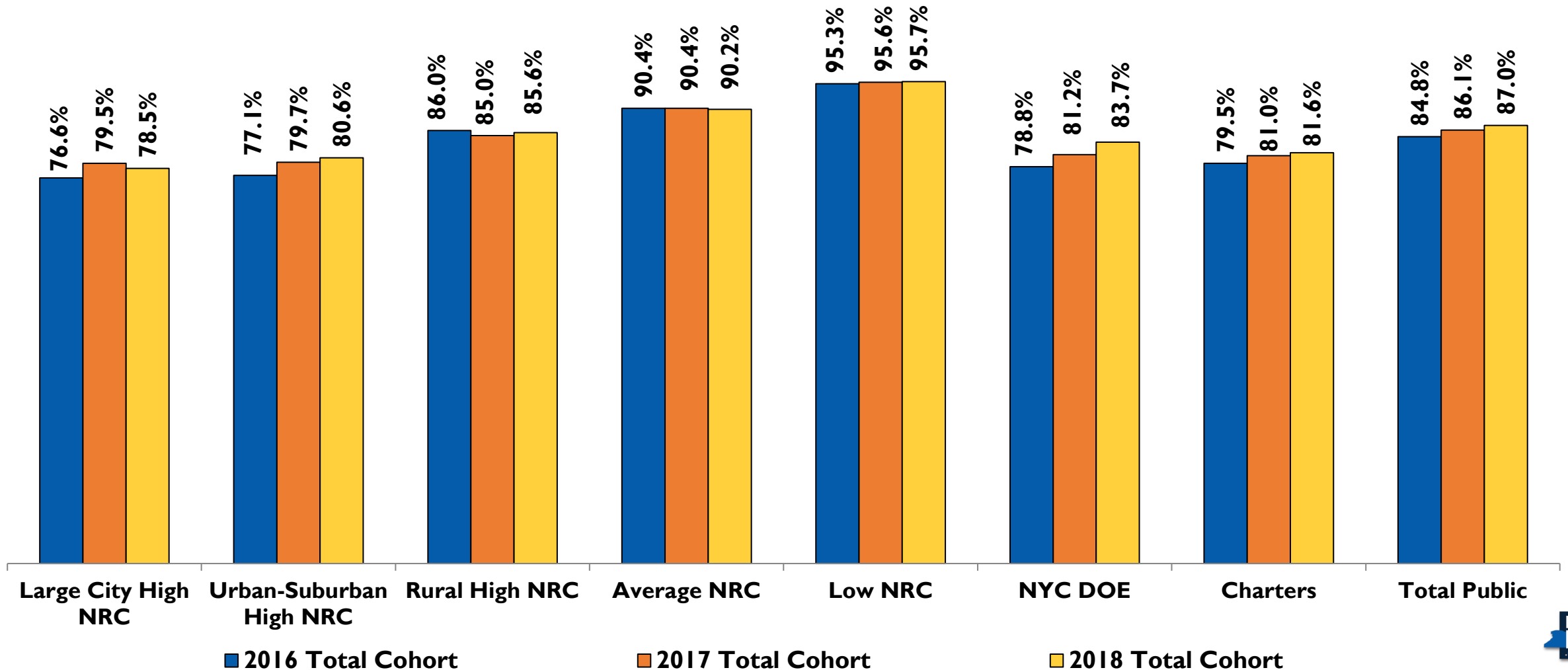

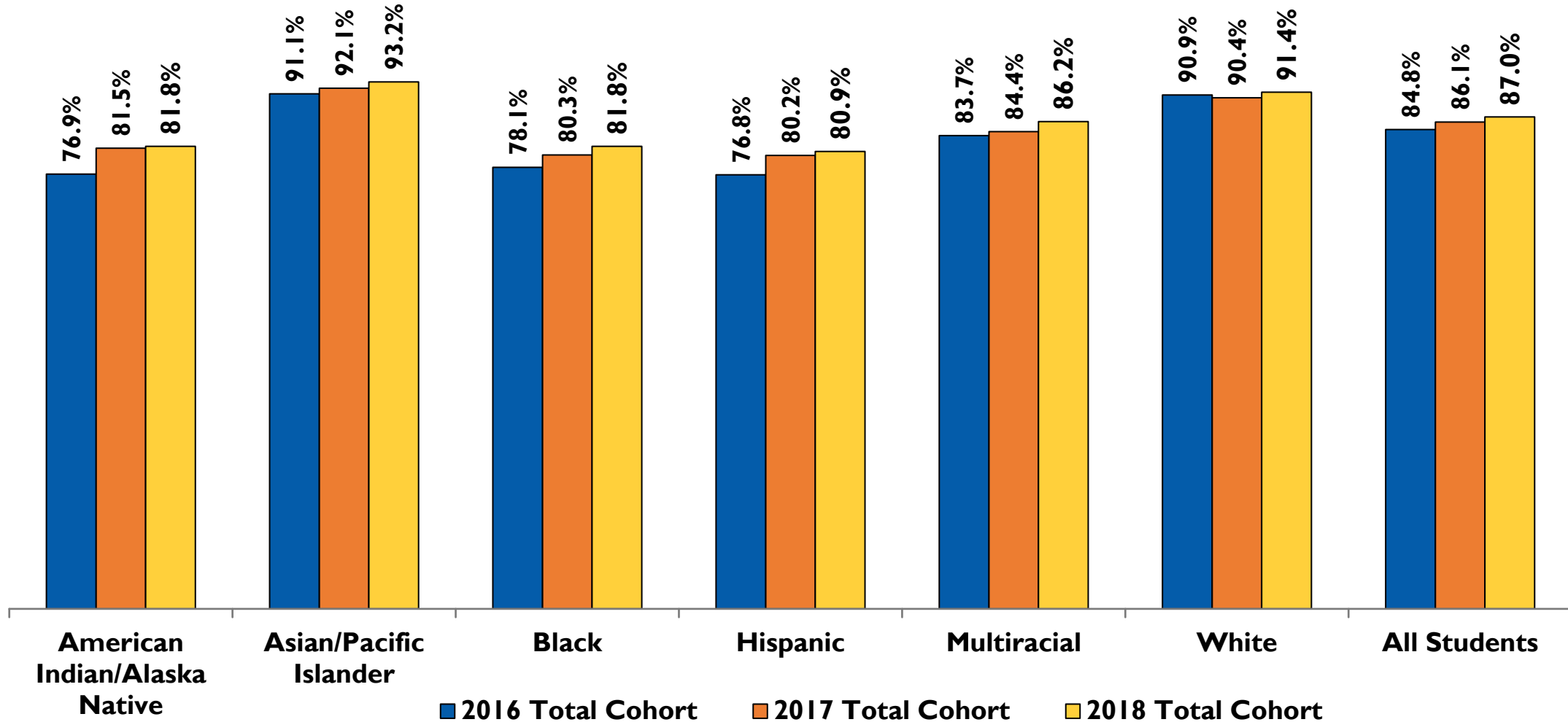
PERCENTAGE OF GRADUATES AFTER 4 YEARS THROUGH AUGUST, ALL STUDENTS

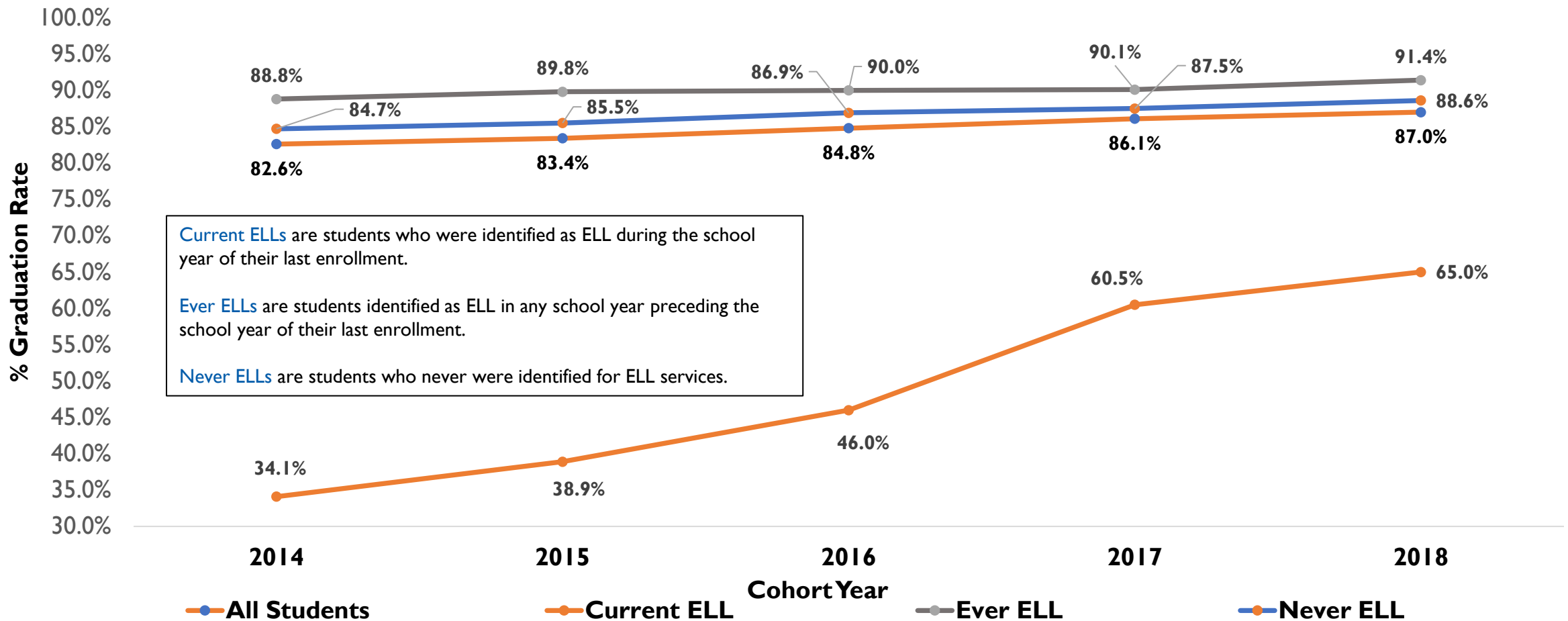

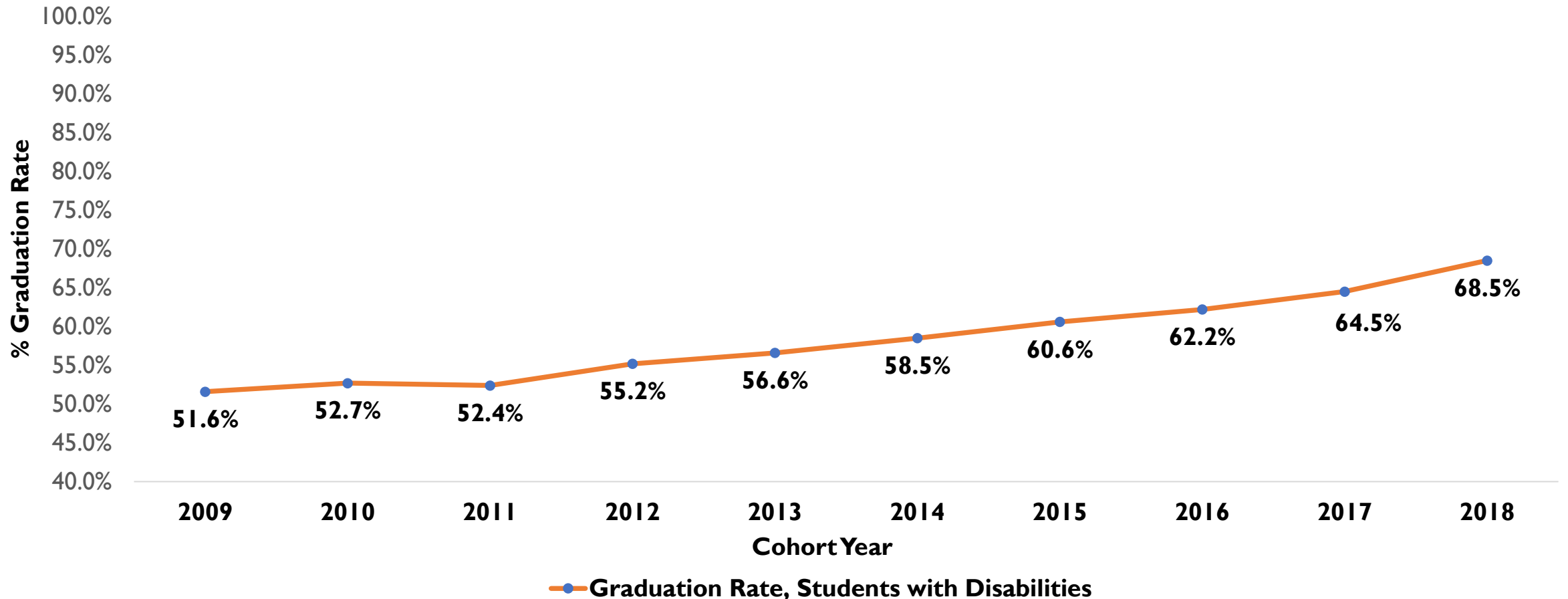

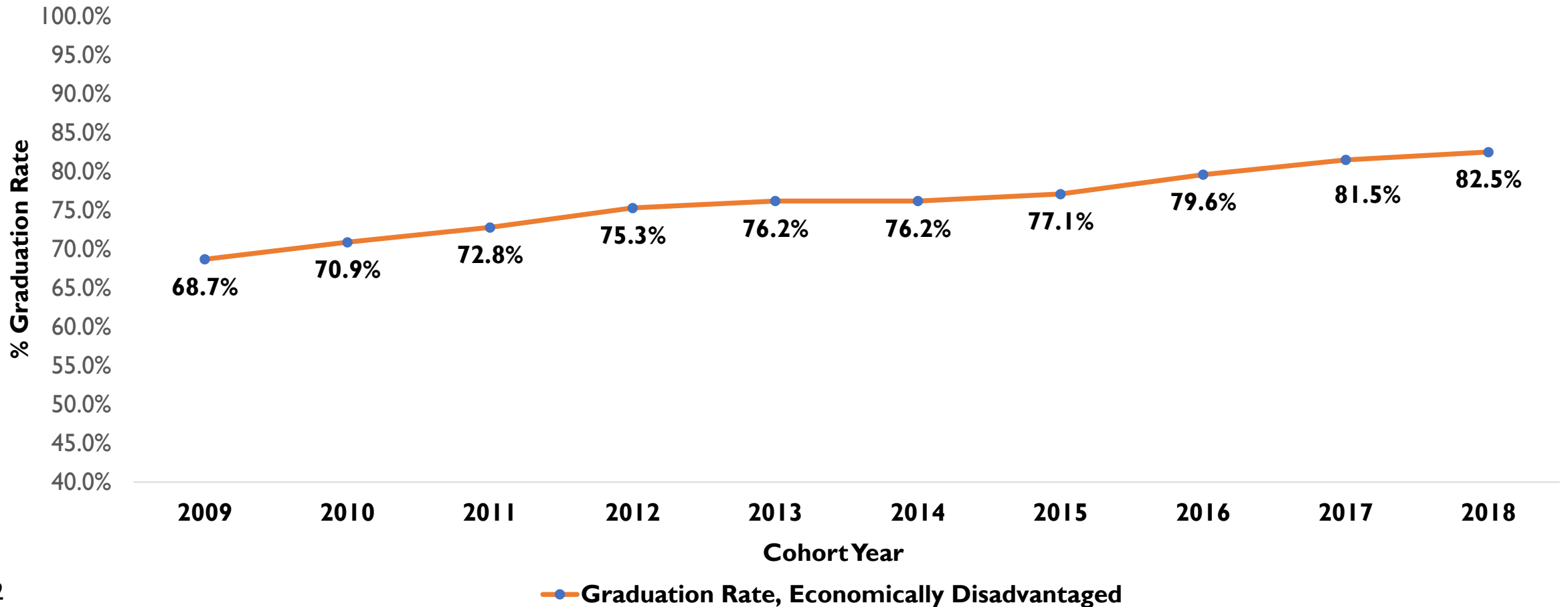
