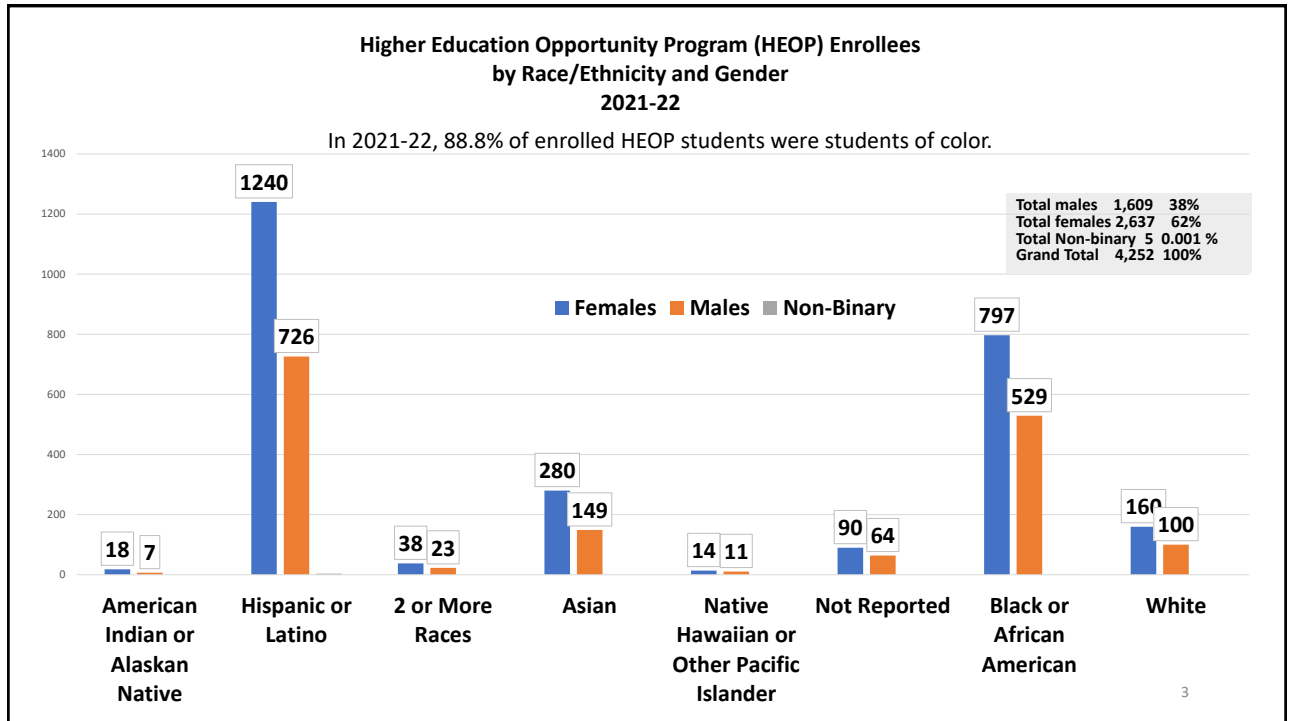

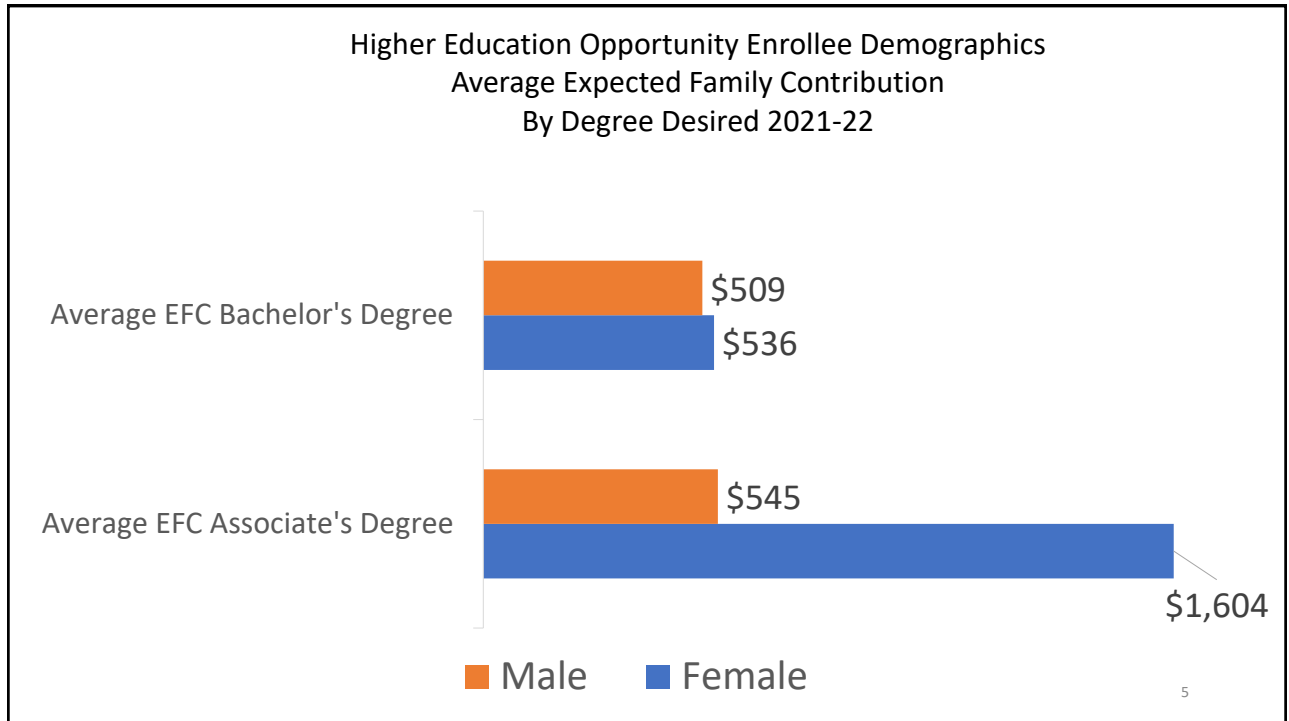

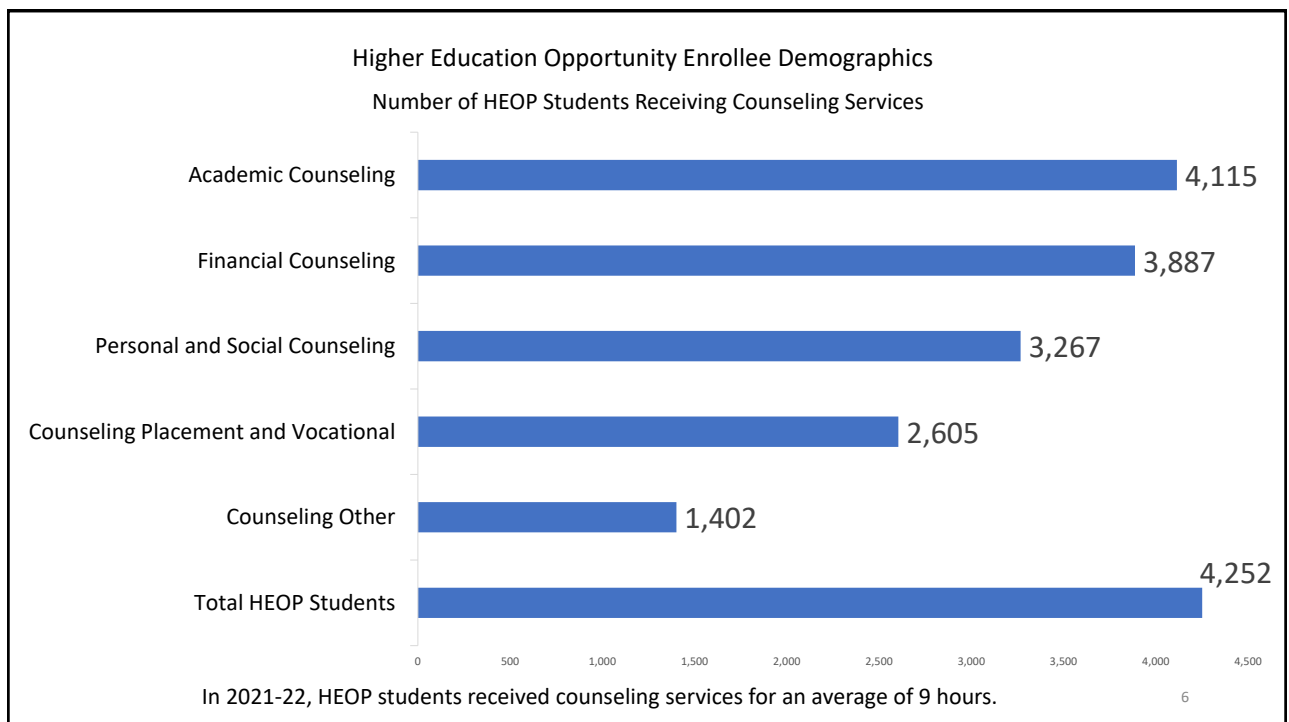
The data suggests that Native Hawaiian or OPI HEOP students have the greatest cumulative loan totals.

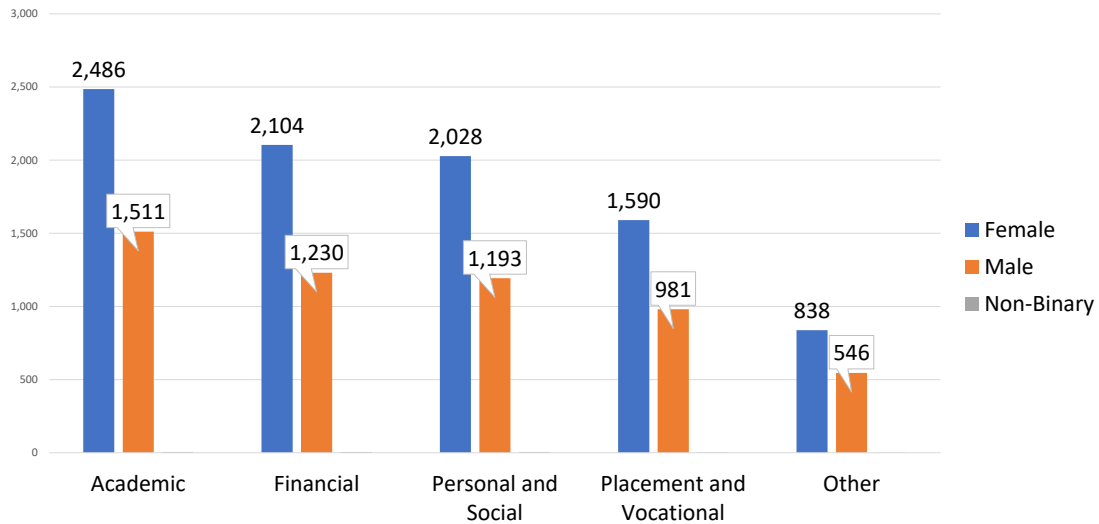

Higher Education Opportunity Enrollee Demographics Counseling Services Offered to HEOP Students By Gender For those Seeking a Bachelor's degree 2021-22

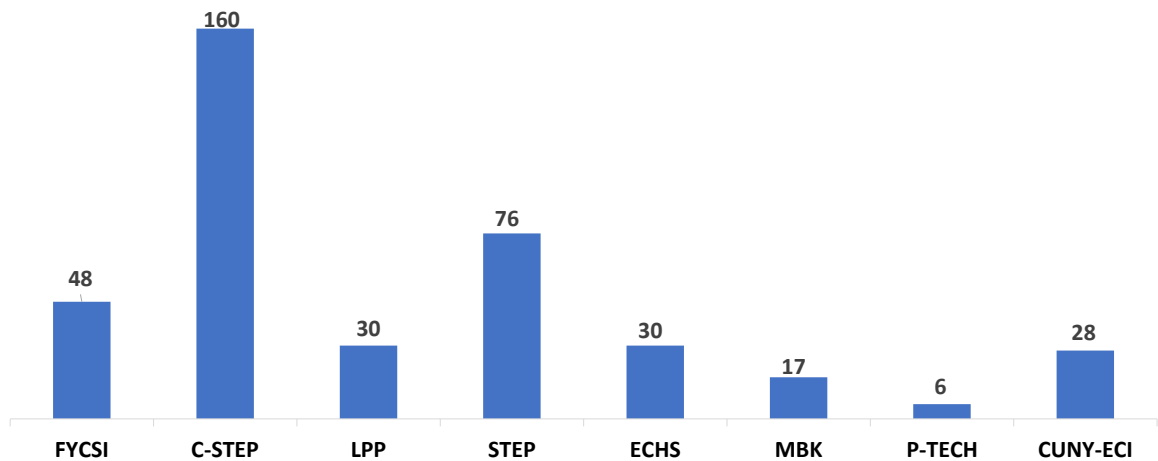


In 2021-22 the vast majority of HEOP students seeking a Bachelor's Degree received academic and financial counseling services.

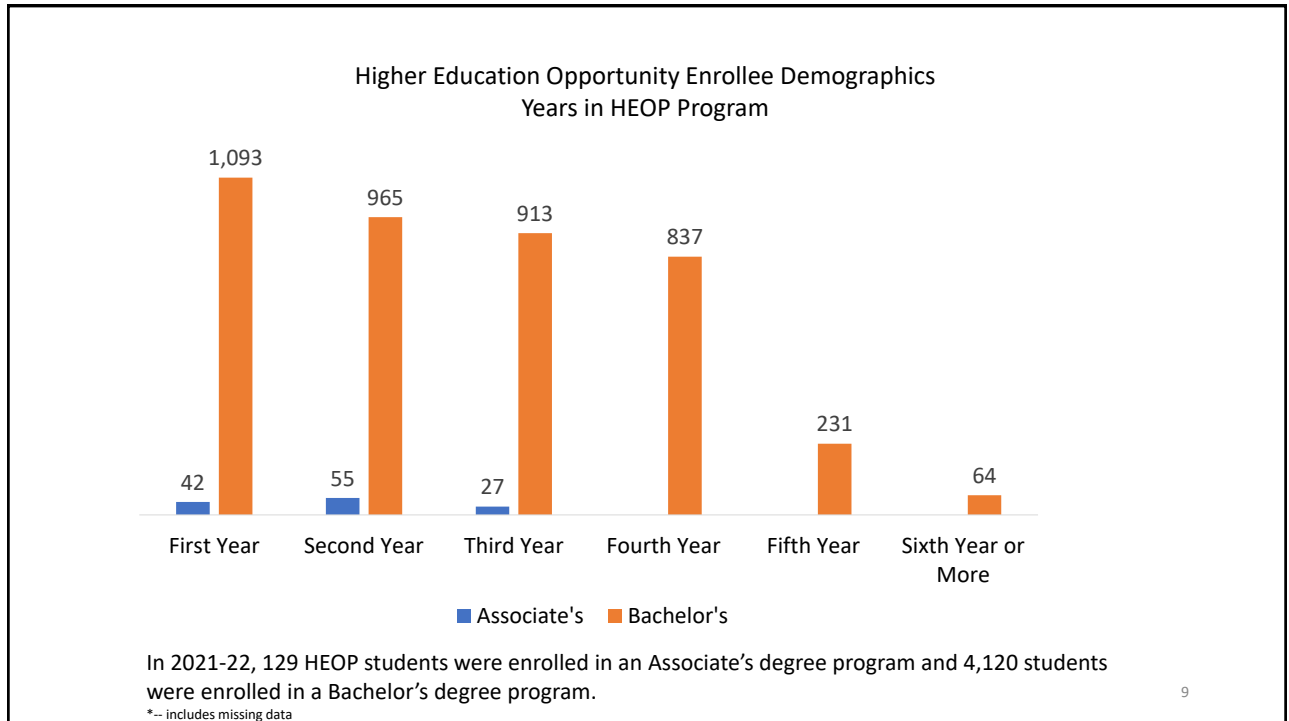

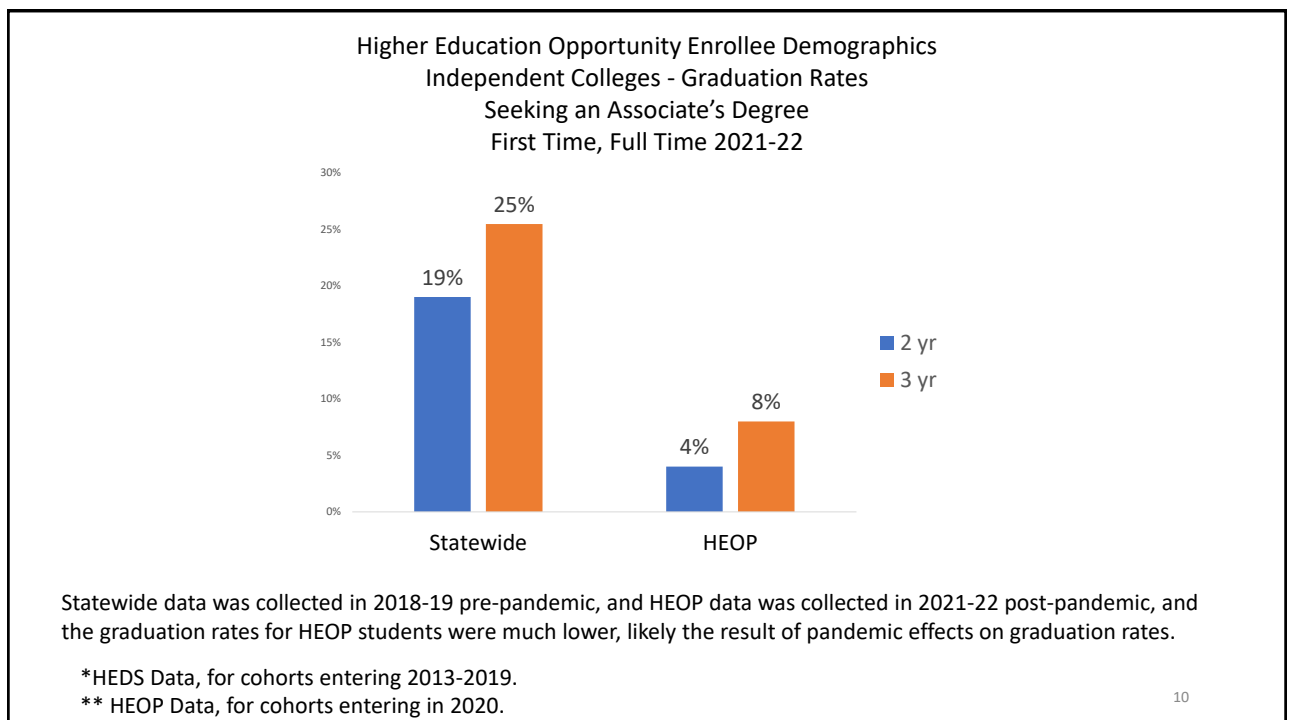
In 2021-22, of those reporting, a total of 395 HEOP students have participated in other Opportunity Programs.

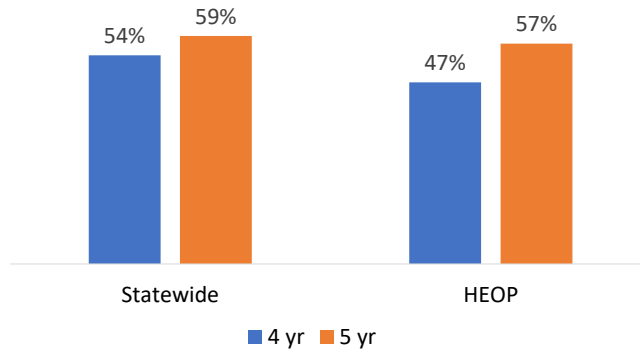

First Time, Full Time 2021-22

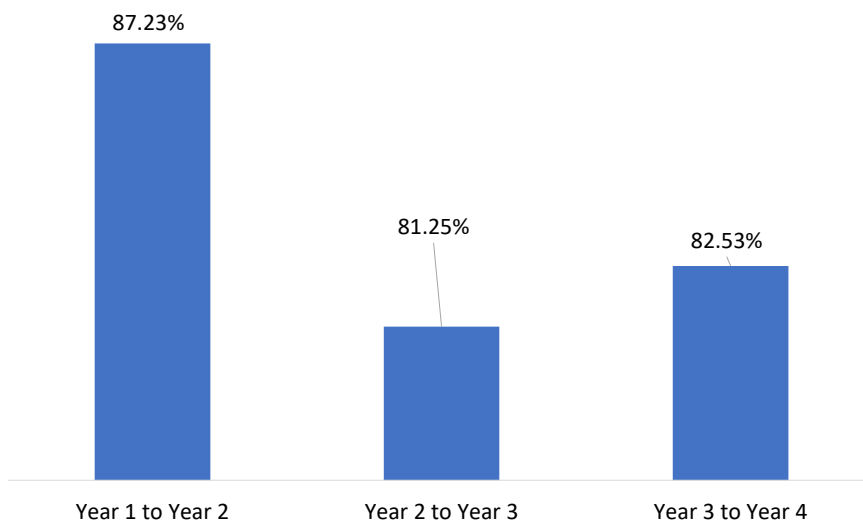

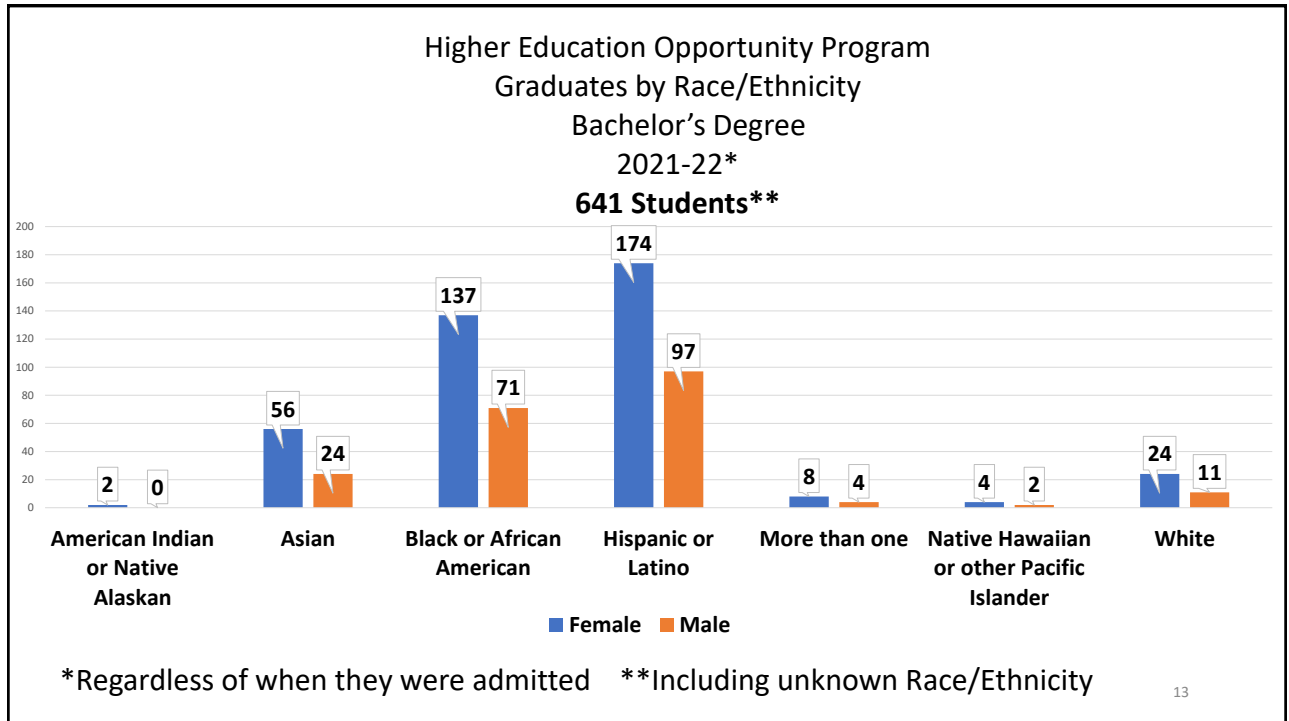
