

In 2023-2024, 89.7% of enrolled HEOP students were students of color.




The data suggests that Native Hawaiian or OPI HEOP students have the greatest cumulative loan totals.

### Number of HEOP Students Receiving Counseling Services




In 2023-2024, HEOP students received counseling services for an average of 8 hours.


## Counseling Services Offered to HEOP Students By Gender

### For those Seeking a Bachelor's degree 2023-2024




In 2023-2024 the vast majority of HEOP students seeking a Bachelor's Degree received academic and financial counseling services.

HEOP Students Enrolled in Other Concurrent, Collegiate Opportunity Programs




In 2023-2024, of those reporting, a total of 217

In 2023-2024, of those reporting, a total of 125 HEOP students had been enrolled in other pre-collegiate Opportunity Programs.


## Higher Education Opportunity Enrollee Demographics Years in HEOP Program





First Time, Full Time 2023-2024




