## Identification Methodology for Recognition Schools based on 2018-19 School Year Results

- 1. Schools that have an accountability status of Good Standing are first grouped into elementary/middle schools and high schools. A school with both elementary/middle and high school levels will have its data analyzed for each of the levels separately and must meet the criteria for both levels, contingent upon the school having a valid composite measure for both.
- 2. The school must have met one of the following Identification Criteria for the All Students subgroup for each grade level (elementary/middle and high school) for which the school is accountable:

- 3. The school must not have any subgroups that were identified as Potential Targeted Support & Improvement (PTSI) based upon 2018-19 school year results (i.e., 2019-20 school year accountability designations).
- 4. The All Students subgroup must not have a 2018-19 Participation Rate for English Language Arts or Math that is less than 95%. If a school did not have enough students (less than 40) to receive a participation rate, the school is still eligible to be identified as a Recognition School.
