Identification Methodology for Recognition Schools based on 2017-18 School Year Results

- 1. Schools that have an accountability status of Good Standing are first grouped into elementary/middle schools and high schools. Schools with both elementary/middle and high school levels will have the data analyzed for each of the levels separately and must meet the criteria for both levels, contingent upon having a valid composite measure for both.
- 2. The school must have met one of the following Identification Criteria for the All Students subgroup.

- 4. The All Students subgroup must not have a 2017-18 Participation Rate for ELA or Math that is less than 95%. If a school did not have enough students to receive a participation rate, the school is still eligible to be identified as a Recognition School.
