

COURSE: HOME FURNISHINGS

OVERVIEW OF COURSE

Goal

The goal of this course is to expand the students' experiences in housing and design through detailed exploration of the home furnishings industry.

Description

Home Furnishings is designed to teach students how to work with woods and textiles in the home. Each module will provide students with an opportunity to develop an understanding of the techniques necessary to create a project in that category. It is a "how to" course which includes an extensive hands-on project as part of the requirements. Skills developed will be related to careers.

Skills, Knowledge, and Behaviors to be Developed

The ability to:

1. Identify related careers.
2. Identify the wood types used in furniture.
3. Make simple repairs on wood furniture.
4. Understand furniture refinishing techniques and corresponding safety considerations.
5. Explain decorative and functional roles of textiles in home furnishings.
6. Demonstrate a specific skill by the completion of a project which reflects this curriculum.
