Our admissions policy provides for lottery preference for families eligible for free and reducedprice lunch. We will set aside $50 \%$ of our open seats for economically disadvantaged applicants.

Recruitment will occur throughout neighborhoods surrounding the schools and in the local district that have high percentages of families receiving free and reduced-price lunch.

We have updated our website based on community input, questions, and feedback to be more user-friendly. School policy provides subsidy for F/R families for extracurriculars as needed.

Our application is available in multiple languages (English and Spanish). Spanish translation is offered at our admissions information sessions.

Mandarin translation is provided, as needed, by staff.

Brochures are distributed in Spanish and English. We provide outreach by multi-lingual staff and in immigrant communities.
