HPCS used various outreach efforts in 2021-22 to attract and retain students who are at risk of academic failure and will continue to adopt and implement new measures designed to retain such students in 2022-23 and beyond. Specifically, we contact guidance counselors in elementary, middle and high schools in Community School District 5 in order to identify high needs students who could naturally feed into Democracy Prep Charter School. We also depend on analytical tools to inform recruitment decisions. With support from network resources, Democracy Prep is informed on the neighborhood demographic trends, application to acceptance conversion rates, and previous year's retention rates. This equips canvassers with more targeted walk lists and recruitment strategies.

Economically Disadvantaged

Democracy Prep Charter School will begin to advertise open registration in October each year, and conducts Open Houses beginning in January. Interested families will meet with staff and review the expectations of the school. Canvassing staff will visit, with permission, local elementary schools, after school programs, and youth centers, organize numerous open houses, attend school enrollment fairs, canvass neighborhoods door to door to further reach interested families, mail applications to every eligible family in CSD 5, and post flyers and notices in local newspapers, supermarkets, and community centers. 2022-23 in-person canvassing plans and school building-based recruitment events may be revised based on Department of Health guidelines related to COVID-19.

English Language Learners

Students with Disabilities
