This notice is to inform you that Democracy Prep Endurance Charter School (DPE) has requested a revision to its charter so that DPE students can participate in a new special education program called Democracy Prep Pathways. Pathways will be an addition to Democracy Prep's current special education program, and will take place at 240 East 123rd Street in CSD 6.

Pathways is proposed to be an intensive, transitional program to serve eight to 10 DPE sixth grade students with disabilities in 2015-2016, potentially growing by one to two students per year. In addition to DPE Students, Pathways will serve students with disabilities from other Democracy Prep network schools. Pathways is a new program (not a new school or grade), and is designed as a one year intensive intervention for Grade 6 students, with a plan to provide transitional support after students leave the program and return to their home Democracy Prep schools. Pathways would permit DPE to provide more targeted and specialized services than those currently available at DPE.

Across its network, 30% of Democracy Prep's sixth graders are SWDs, and Pathways will service only a small fraction of those students. Pathways students will be identified based on recommendations in their individualized education programs (IEPs) by the Committee on Special Education (CSE), and when the nature or severity of the disability of a student is such that education in regular classes with the use of supplementary aids and services cannot be achieved satisfactorily in accordance with 20 U.S.C. 1412(a)(5)(A)-(B); 34 CFR §§300.114-300.120.
