

The EOC headstart program s a primary feeder school for RCA	

Economically Disadvantaged	kindergarten seats. We also visit the Hempstead Public Library Family Center.  RCA has a longstand ng relationship with EOC. For example, we invite their staff to present at RCA parent workshops on topic such as nutrition, domestic violence, and immigration documentation.  Since they have pre-k expertise in early childhood we refer our families with this need to consider registering early for the program. Further, RCA also acts as a resource n the EOC's interagency meetings to provide feedback and nformation about family needs at RCA.  All school enrollment applications and flyers mention that the school accommodates students with disabilities, English language learners and participates in the free and reduced lunch program.	In 2019-20 RCACS has 92% of the enrollment dentified as economically disadvantaged, whereas the local district enrolls 75% ED students.
	To attract more families who speak a language other than English, we offer our advertising materials in Spanish, which is the primary language of families with English language learners in our area. We provide Spanish flyers at local daycares, EOC headstarts, and visit and provide flyers at Circulo De La Hispanidad, which is a local organization that serves Spanish-speaking families. Our lottery and registration materials are translated into Spanish. We also have a bilingual staff member	

English Language Learners/Multilingual Learners	who helps answer families' questions and fill out paperwork. Prior to and during registration, we host an open house meeting in Spanish where parents can become familiar with our curriculum, program benefits, and services.  Many of our ELL applicants come to RCA based on word-of-mouth recommendation. Our ELL families have high rates of satisfaction with the school; our average retention rate for ELLs s consistently near 100%.  All school enrollment applications and flyers mention that the school accommodates students with disabilities, English language learners and participates in the free and reduced lunch program.  In 2019-20, RCAC ensured that our online application and instructions are translated nto Spanish.	In 2019-20, our percentage of ELLs was 11% and RUFSD enrolled 30%. We recognize that our enrollment of ELLs s far below the district, however, we have increased the enrollment of ELLs in each of the past five years and we will continue to increase focus on our recruitment practices to ensure further growth n ELLs at RCACS.




