This notice is to inform you that on March 18, 2017 the New York State Board of Regents received seven new applications to establish charter schools in New York City as reflected in the attached chart. These applications are under review for possible action at the June 12-13, 2017 meeting of the Board of Regents. Full application materials may be viewed at www.p12.nysed.gov/psc/startcharter.

Please note that pursuant to Education Law section 2857(1) and 8 NYCRR 119.4 (available at http://www.p12.nysed.gov/psc/publichearing.html), the school district of location is required to hold a public hearing to solicit comments from the community in connection with the foregoing applications. These hearings, which are required to be held within the community that is potentially impacted by the charter school, must be held within 30 days of your receipt of this letter. Having been in regular communication about the hearings with Jennifer Nagourney since late March, I understand that all of the hearings have been scheduled, and most hearings have occurred.

Please provide the following required documentation:

- 1. A copy of the public hearing notice at the time of dissemination.
- 2. Written confirmation that the hearing was held no later than the next business day following the hearing.
- 3. Copies of any and all written records or comments generated from this hearing must be sent within 15 business days after the hearing.

All documentation listed above should be submitted electronically to charterschools@nysed.gov (the subject line of the email should include the NAME OF PROPOSED CHARTER SCHOOL *Public Hearing*).

In addition, the New York City Department of Education has the right to comment directly to the Board of Regents on the programmatic and fiscal impact of the proposed charter school(s) on traditional public and non-public schools in your district. Comments should be submitted no later than June 8, 2017 to charterschools@nysed.gov (the subject line of the email should read: *New York City Department of Education response to* NAME OF PROPOSED CHARTER SCHOOL *application*).
