Please note that pursuant to Education Law section 2857(1) and 8 NYCRR 119.4 (available at http://www.p12.nysed.gov/psc/publichearing.html), the school district of location is required to hold a public hearing to solicit comments from the community relating to the foregoing applications. These hearings, which are required to be held within the community that is potentially impacted by the charter school, must be held within 30 days of your receipt of this letter.

Please provide the following required documentation:

- 3. Copies of all written records or comments generated from this hearing must be sent within 15 business days after the hearing.

In addition, Homer Central School District has the right to comment directly to the Board of Regents on the programmatic and fiscal impact of the proposed charter school(s) on traditional public and non-public schools in your district. Comments should be submitted no later than November 1, 2017 to charterschools@nysed.gov (the subject line of the email should read: Homer CSD response to NAME OF PROPOSED CHARTER SCHOOL application).
