RE: New York State Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) Guidance and Resources for Emergency Child Care Due to Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Outbreak in New York State

Pursuant to Executive Orders 202.4 and 202.5, school districts, charter schools, and nonpublic schools were to close no later than Wednesday, March 18, 2020, for a period of two weeks, as a result of the outbreak of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) occurring in New York State.

In addition to COVID-19 closure plans for alternative instructional options and distribution and availability of meals, the Executive Orders direct school leaders to establish COVID-19 child care plans, with an emphasis on serving children of parents in the health care profession or first responders who are critical to the response effort.

To assist school leaders with developing, submitting and implementing child care plans, the <u>New</u> <u>York State Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS)</u> has provided the following guidance and resources:
