# Data Privacy and Security Quick Reference For Superintendents

## Laws you must know:

- ♠ Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)
- New York Education Law § 2-d and Part 121 of the regulations of the Commissioner of Education

## What's required under Education Law § 2-d and Part 121?

- Districts must enter into a data protection agreement (DPA) when sharing student data with third party contractors (includes studies, research, and audits (but not OSC audits))
- ⚠ Districts must post supplemental information for such contracts on their website
  - A4L (Access 4 Learning Community) SDPC Resource Registry
- ⚠ Districts must designate a Data Protection Officer (DPO)
- Districts must adopt a Parents Bill of Rights and it must be on their website
- Districts must annually train officers and employees in data privacy and security awareness
- Districts must <u>report</u> data breaches and unauthorized disclosures and releases to the NYSED Privacy Office
- Parents and/or eligible students must be notified when their PII is subject to an unauthorized disclosure
- 6 Student data cannot be sold or used for commercial or marketing purposes

# Policies your district cannot live without:

- FERPA Annual Notification to Parents
- ♠ Incident response plan
- Parents Bill of Rights
- Data security and privacy policy
  - Adopts NIST CSF

#### Filing a data incident report for unauthorized disclosures and breaches:

- ♠ Erroneous or accidental disclosures
- Other disclosures − hacking, malicious attacks, vendor problems
