Universal Prekindergarten (UPK) and Statewide Universal Full-Day

Prekindergarten (SUFDPK) Children in SIRS

Date: September 21, 2023

Each spring, school districts are required to report their prekindergarten (PreK) child counts (enrollment numbers), regardless of the funding that supports their program. For the 2023-24 school year, all student counts must be inputted via the Student Information Repository System (SIRS) and the SED Monitoring and Vendor Performance System, as applicable, on or before the close of business on March 13, 2024.


For the 2023-2024 school year, PreK child counts must reflect **the actual PreK enrollment** as of March 13, 2024. Please note that this is a change from previous years. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, districts were temporarily given an opportunity to report enrollment through multiple




LEAS WITH CONVERSION STUDENTS USING STATE 0409 AND 0545/0546
