



A. Use of the Optional Subcomponent



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B. Assurances

- All assurances are mandatory.
- In Task 8, assurances are included in Tasks 8.1 and 8.4.
- Be sure to always read, understand, and check all assurances.

Task 8.1) Assurances

Please check the boxes below.

Assure that if a principal receives an overall rating of Ineffective on the Student Performance category, and a State-designed supplemental assessment (option B) was included as an Optional subcomponent of the Student Performance category, then the principal must be rated Ineffective overall (see Education Law §3012-d(5)(a) and (7)).


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Assure that if a principal receives an overall rating of Ineffective on the Student Performance category, and a State-provided growth score on a State-created or administered test (option A1 or A2) was included as an Optional subcomponent of the Student Performance category, then the principal may not be rated higher than Developing overall (see Education Law §3012-d(5)(a) and (7)).



- A. Use of the Optional Subcomponent
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- The measure in the Optional subcomponent shall apply in a consistent manner, to the extent practicable, across all buildings with the same grade configuration or program in the district/BOCES and be either:
 - (A) a second State-provided growth score on a State-created or administered test; provided that the State-provided growth measure is different than that used in the Required subcomponent in the Student Performance category; or
 - (B) a growth score based on a State-designed supplemental assessment, calculated using a State-provided or approved growth model.



- The district/BOCES will first enter the lowest and highest grade of the building/program, then select a measure.
- Once a measure has been selected from the dropdown menu, a corresponding menu of assessments, fill-in box or assurance will appear.


- Option (B) is a growth score based on a State-designed supplemental assessment, calculated using a State-provided or approved growth model.

Please describe the process your district/BOCES will use to calculate a 0-20 score and HEDI rating using a principal-specific growth score computed by the State based on the percentage of students who achieve a State-determined level of growth. Please also include an upload in Task 8.3 demonstrating the process of assigning all points 0 to 20.

Principals of grades 5-8 will be assigned a principal-specific growth score based on the percentage of students in the building whose Student Growth Percentile (SGP) is above the State Median SGP on NYS Assessments in ELA and Math (grades 5-8). Principals of grades 9-12 will be assigned a principal-specific growth score based on the percentage of students in the building whose Student Growth Percentile (SGP) is above the State Median SGP on all the Common Core English Regents and the Common Core Algebra Regents.

• In addition, an upload is required in Task 8.3 demonstrating the process of assigning all points 0 to 20.



 If Option (A2) – <u>school-wide</u> growth results using available Stateprovided growth scores that are locally computed – is selected, a corresponding fill-in box will appear at the end of the task to address the process for assigning a 0-20 score and HEDI rating.
