#### **Submission Packages**

All PR submission packages must be <u>emailed</u> to the Fiscal Associate for the school district. Hard copies may be requested.

#### **New Project Requests**

New Project Requests must be submitted prior to the submission of a preliminary review or BAU recalculation.

The project # assigned to this PR will be used on the ISR and floorplans.

#### **Prescreening**

All preliminary review submissions will be prescreened to ensure a complete package has been received. The PR submission will not be put in the PR review queue until all the items on the check list are received and deemed complete.

#### STEAM/STEM Additions

Elementary School: 27 grade K-6 BAUs for a STEAM/STEM classroom addition

Secondary School: 24 grade 7-9 or 7-12 BAUs for a STEAM/STEM classroom addition

### Secure Vestibule

\*\*A secure vestibule addition must be a main entrance and the addition to create the actual vestibule in order to be eligible for building aid\*\*

NYSED allows BAUs for a secure vestibule addition at an instructional building or bus garage main entrance. These BAUs are one-time only and do not carry forward.

Elementary School: 20 grade K-6 BAUs for a secure vestibule addition

Secondary School: 15 grade 7-9 or 7-12 BAUs for a secure vestibule addition
