Dear Mr. Johnson:

In accordance with Chapter 19 of the Laws of 2020, Dr. William Johnson, the fiscal monitor that the department appointed to the Hempstead Union Free School District ("the District"), has provided me with his findings in regard to the District's proposed budget for the 2021-22 school year. Using the State enacted budget as the basis for his analysis, Dr. Johnson has found that the proposed budget is balanced within the context of revenue and expenditure estimates, which Dr. Johnson has updated to reflect the State enacted budget and mandated programs. Mr. Johnson has also found that to the greatest extent possible, the proposed budget is consistent with the district's approved academic and financial plans. Dr. Johnson has shared these findings with you and the other members of the Board of Education.

Because Dr. Johnson has not submitted to me any recommendations on the proposed budget, the District is now required to make available on the District's website the initial proposed budget, the monitor's findings, and the final proposed budget no later than seven days prior to the date of the District's budget hearing.

I wish to congratulate the Board of Education for the development of a proposed budget that the monitor has found to be balanced and consistent with the District's approved financial plan. As Dr. Johnson has indicated, the 2021-22 school year is an unusual one in terms of the unprecedented infusion of State and Federal resources into the District, and the Board of Education must be diligent in ensuring that the District remains on track to long-term fiscal stability once these resources are no longer available.

We look forward to approval of the proposed budget by the Hempstead community and to continuing to work with you to ensure that all students in the District receive the support they need to succeed.
