



A CARING COMMUNITY

My administrative team must understand my vision and the mission of each day.

The students are priority **#1** – For many this might be the most attention they get.

A support system is put in place to maximize success, healthy mindfulness, and communication.

Saunders has 1160 students and between all administrators we know every one of them!

LOOPING

Each grade level has a team that took over an incoming ninth grade, and will carry them across the stage for graduation. Each grade level team consists of:

- a. an assistant principal
- b. a guidance counselor
- c. a grade level supervisor (teacher assignment)
- d. a school safety officer

These four people are responsible for knowing everything about the students in their class.

Family, address, all phone numbers, extended family, family issues, occupations, illnesses, friends, external problems.

TEDDY

Teddy comes from a family with very limited means. Earlier in the year, his grandfather passed away and had to be buried through the welfare system. His father is a waiter and his mother bounced around doing minimum wage jobs.

I often fed him, paid for him to go on my college trip, and would have to drive him home occasionally because he had no money for a bus. The family lived on the south side of town in a small apartment, and as the only child, Teddy and his parents had a great bond.

In early July, I received a phone call at 3:00 am. It was Teddy. He was crying and told me his mother died suddenly (38) and he did not know what to do.



RELATIONSHIPS

SENIOR EXIT PROJECTS


No student can graduate from **Saunders Trades and Technical High School without** successfully completing and orally defending their exit project. (Literacy!)

Several years ago, a wounded veteran from the US Special forces (who requested to be unramed), had a dream to build a huge house on over 113 scress of property in Dutchess county, in the midst of construction, he came to the realization that the property could have a purpose; to help wounded veterans like himself. This began the Wounded Veterans Project.




