LEAs must provide private schools with opportunities for timely and meaningful consultation prior to completion of the form. Consultation must address all topics identified on the form. The form **MUST** be completed by the public school official in consultation with private school officials.

Any data reported in SIRS will be used to populate the Comprehensive Information Report (CIR) and used for mandated services.

LEAs must provide private schools with opportunities for timely and meaningful consultation prior to completion of the form. Consultation must address all topics identified on the form. The form **MUST** be completed by the public school official in consultation with private school officials.

\* It is important to note that individual LEAs will require private school officials to complete and return this form prior to August 31<sup>st</sup> since the LEAs must submit their applications to NYSED by this date.

# September

## Early September 2023

Mandated Services Aid (MSA) & Comprehensive Attendance Policy (CAP)-Guidelines, announcement of aid and forms for the 2022-23 school year are expected to be made available by September 2023. The most efficient way to submit your MSA/CAP claim is utilizing the online system available through the <u>NYSED Business Portal Website</u>. We anticipate the 2022-2023 school year will become available by December 2023 with a due date for submission of claims by April 1, 2024 and payment by May 31, 2024. A full listing of the mandates and a brief explanation of each one can be found on the Office of Religious and Independent School Support website.

<u>Review of Students' Immunizations</u>-Student immunizations are to be reviewed in September. Students who are not in compliance within 14 days of the start of the school year, which may be extended to 30 days for students from out of state or country who demonstrate a good faith effort to comply, are not allowed to attend school until they meet the immunization requirements. See the <u>Department of Health chart on immunization requirements for the 2023-2024 school year</u>. Questions on immunizations may be directed to the NYS Bureau of Immunizations: <u>osas@health.ny.gov</u>. Questions on school implementation of the requirements may be directed to the NYSED Office of Student Support Services at <u>StudentSupportServices@nysed.gov</u>.

Schools must sign up for the <u>New York State Immunization Information System (NYSIIS)</u> or the <u>Citywide Immunization Registry (CIR)</u> - NYC Health for schools located in NYC. Public Health Law requires healthcare providers to report all immunizations administered to persons less than 19 years of age, along with the person's immunization histories to either NYSIIS or CIR. Schools can access student immunization records and track compliance in either system.

Annual Religious and Independent School Building Fire Safety Report-online submission Education Law 807-A requires annual inspection of all schools located outside of New York City, with grades 1-12 with at least 25 students, and all nurseries and kindergartens with at least 6 students. Initial fire inspections performed between July 1<sup>st</sup> and December 1<sup>st</sup> can be used to meet this annual requirement. The annual fire safety inspection report is due by December 16, 2023. **Health Services-** Education Law 912 requires school districts in New York State to provide resident students attending religious and independent schools with any/all the same health and welfare services available to students attending schools in the district. It is strongly recommended that the religious or independent school principal communicate with the school district superintendent regarding the best time to submit the request for health services. This letter of request for health services should specify exactly what services are being requested. It recommended that such requests be reviewed annually.

**Occupational Education-** In order to arrange for participation in an occupational education program, the parent of a religious or independent school pupil must file a written request with the board of education of the district in which the pupil resides by **June 1**. The administrator of a religious or independent school may receive and forward the requests for the parents to the board of education.

<u>Gifted Education-</u> A parent should apply for dual enrollment services to the district of residence. Requests for participation must be filed with the board of education of the district of residence on or before **June 1** preceding the school year for which the request is made.

<u>**Textbook Loan**</u>- The administrator prepares textbook requests for the coming year and submits them to parents or district. The law allows a board of education to set a date by which the districts must receive requests for textbooks loans, but this date cannot be earlier than **June 1** of the year preceding that for which textbooks are requested.

#### Spring Deadlines as determined by public school districts:

**Library Loan-**While the law does not specify a date, the religious or independent school administrator is urged to assemble and submit requests to the public school district in the spring before the year in which the programs will be used.

<u>Software Loan-</u>While the law does not specify a date, the religious or independent school administrator is urged to assemble and submit requests to the public school district in the spring before the year in which the programs will be used.

**<u>Hardware Loan</u>**-While the law does not specify a date, the religious or independent School administrator is urged to assemble and submit requests to the public school district in the spring before the year in which the programs will be used.
