The cohort exceeded the 1.0% cap in math at 1.17% and in ELA at 1.33%. This variance in percentage was due to the fact that 3748 total students participated in the math assessment and 2985 students participated in ELA. Of the total eligible students, 1256 students opted out of taking the ELA exam and 1230 opted out of taking the Math exam. In addition, 9 students were absent or not scored for the duration of the testing window in ELA. In addition, 4 students were absent or not scored for the duration of the testing window in Math. The total number of eligible students to participate in the NYS grades 3-8 assessment was 4329. Given this information, if all eligible students took the ELA and Math exam then our actual percentage would be 1.0%. Furthermore, of the 44 students assessed in grades 3-8 for NYSAA, several of the students were new to the District. Of the 44 students, 12 students moved into the District between the 2019 and 2021 school year. Of the 12 new students, 11 of the students were identified as being NYSAA.
