



## SUPPORTING ALLISON'S SUCCESS

It is your right to request that your child's school provide translated forms and materials and an interpreter for meetings, if needed. It is important to encourage your child to complete assignments, participate in class, and ask questions. It is also recommended that parents attend their child's parent-teacher conference(s). In addition to the parent-teacher conference(s), your child's school is also obligated to provide an additional conference every year regarding your child's English language development. You can also request additional meetings to discuss your child's academics or other concerns by contacting their teachers or school administrators. Some topics you may want to discuss include:

- The amount, length, and type of English as a New Language (ENL) services your child is entitled to receive.
- The difference between ENL and bilingual programs and the availability of bilingual programs in your child's school/district.
- Additional programs (morning, after-school, summer, etc.) to help your child with their English language development.
- The type of home language supports that teachers are using in the classroom.
- Resources, websites, and other interactive ways you can support your child in English and their home language.
- Your child's progress in speaking, listening, reading, and writing.
