## Additional Funding for 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers

The New York State Education Department (NYSED) has just awarded a limited amount of additional 21<sup>st</sup> Century funds to fully fund three programs that had been partially funded in Round 5 last year and 17 new programs that will be known as Round 5-B. The \$8.9 million became available as the result of unexpended carry-over funds and a small supplemental grant from the U.S. Department of Education. The NYSED determined that this funding was inadequate to conduct a new competition; therefore, it has funded further down the list of Round 5 fundable applications for each geographic area – New York City, the Big Four Cities and the Rest of State. The additional funds were awarded as follows:
