

NYS Seal of Biliteracy Hudson Valley Region 2022-23





The New York State Seal of Biliteracy (NYSSB) recognizes students from district, charter, and non-public schools who have attained **a high level of proficiency in two or more world languages** (one of which must be English) by high school graduation. It acknowledges the importance of biliteracy in today's global society.




The intent of the NYSSB is to:

- affirm the value of diversity in a multilingual society;
- encourage the study of languages;
- identify high school graduates with multilingualism and multiliteracy skills for employers;
- provide universities with additional information about applicants seeking admission;
- prepare students with twenty-first century skills; and
- recognize the value of world and home language instruction in schools.




The NYSSB carries the highest weight on a school's "<u>Readiness Measures</u>", on par with the NYS Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation and Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate exams. This includes current ELLs not in the graduation cohort earning the NYSSB and a Regents Diploma.

of district schools in the Hudson Valley region offered the NYSSB in 2022-23.




The ratios listed are the number of schools offering the NYSSB to the total number of district schools in the region.

In 2022-23, Hudson Valley region students earned the NYSSB in 39 different languages:

Albanian, Arabic, ASL, Bengali, Bulgarian, Czech, Dutch, French, Ga, German, Greek, Guarani, Guyanese, Haitian Creole, Hebrew, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Latin, Latvian, Malayalam, Mandarin, Pashto, Patois, Polish, Portuguese, Punjabi, Romanian, Russian, Spanish, Tagalog, Tamil, Thai, Tigrinya, Turkish, Twi, Ukrainian, Urdu, Yoruba
