NEW YORK STATE LEARNING STANDARDS FOR WORLD LANGUAGES (2021)

September 2023 marks the start of the gradual implementation process for the NYS Learning Standards for World Languages (2021). To support NYS world language educators as they prepare to implement the revised standards, the NYS Education Department’s Office of Bilingual Education and World Languages (NYSED OBEWL) has developed numerous resources in a range of formats that are free and publicly available on the NYSED OBEWL webpage (<http://www.nysed.gov/world-languages>).
