NYS P-TECH Cohort 1 funding update:

NYS P-TECH Cohort 1 projects will be <u>eligible to receive the same amount of funding for the 2020-2021 fiscal year as the amount of funds allocated in the final year of the present grant cycle.</u>
This is based upon the expectation that your project will continue at full participation to recruit 9th graders and oversee a full complement of grades ("9th through 14th") and program services in the upcoming academic year.

If your project is choosing to phase out NYS P-TECH programming, and stop recruiting new students, please contact Jaime Miller at Jaime.Miller@nysed.gov no later than May 15th.

If SED does not receive a confirmation of phase out by May 15th, it is the understanding of SED that you are continuing with programming as previously contracted.

If you are planning to continue full participation, as described above, here are a few items and deadlines of which to be aware as the end of the 2019-2020 academic year approaches. The draft budget should:

- Include use of last year's award amount to complete a 2020-21 FS-10
- Include use of the most current MS Excel version of the FS-10 found in the link below
- Include provision of a detailed Budget Narrative
