CSI Support Options

- Enhancing Principal Leadership (EPL)
 - A program designed to support Principals and District Leaders.
- Instructional Coaching Consortium (ICC)
 - A one-year professional development program to provide ongoing training and follow-up support for instructional coaches.
- High School Redesign
 - A partnership with the Cross State High School Collaborative (CSHSC) to provide support to NYS CSI schools who commit to locally-driven redesign.
- School Comprehensive Education Plan (SCEP) Support Visits
 - Visits focused on the SCEP goals the school developed in order to improve student outcomes, intended to drive the school's improvement initiatives throughout the year.



High School Redesign Professional Learning Session #1

Four Main Topics for the Day:

- Why redesign high schools and why we are redesigning our high school: the big picture and crafting an effective message for stakeholders
- How we are going to work together
- Establishing a shared understanding of school needs and informing high school redesign with student and community voice
- Building a strong high school redesign team and work plan
- Throughout the day, school teams will connect and collaborate, explore evidence-based practices, and engage in design time with the aim to apply learnings to their unique school context.



High School Redesign 2020 Timeline

January 10, 2020	1st Professional Learning Session with Johns Hopkins and NYSED (Syracuse) – "Introduction to HS Redesign"
Mid February 2020	Individual calls with schools to support needs assessment work (Principal, District Contact, Johns Hopkins and NYSED)
March 3&4, 2020	2 nd Professional Learning Session with Johns Hopkins and NYSED (NYC, exact location TBD) – "Learn About Evidence Base for HS Redesign"
Late March	Support meeting (onsite) – Design guidance
April/May 2020	Additional assistance (virtual) as needed
June 2020	Schools submit HS Redesign plan to NYSED
July 2020	Support meeting (onsite or virtual) – Feedback on HS redesign plan
Summer 2020	3 rd Professional Learning Session with Johns Hopkins and NYSED (Buffalo, exact location TBD) – "Initial Launch, Training, and Capacity Building"



SCEP Support Visit Option

- 58 Districts
- 101 Schools & Principals





Vision for SCEP Support Visits

Each visit will be designed to prompt reflection on the SCEP and identify if modifications are needed.

In addition, each visit will have an additional specific purpose based on when the visit occurs:

- October: Identify how early implementation of SCEP is progressing
- January: Learn if Mid-Year Benchmarks were achieved
- March/April: Identify how lessons from 19-20 school inform 20-21 SCEP
- June: Learn if goals were achieved and review draft SCEP

- District Staff invited to attend
